Rference sh 4/15, plan note DETOUR DURATION -STA-62T"Construction work may be performed before and after detour limitation dates, but there shall be no restrictions (lane width reductions, temporary roadways, or one way traffic) to through or local traffic. "We are unable to determine the intent of this note. It appears to be a contradictory. Would it be possible to do the painting on weekdays, or weekends with a lane closure on 62T?

All work to structure STA-62T-37.88 that would require a lane closure must be completed during the detour. No restrictions to traffic will be permitted outside of the detour time. Work that does not affect traffic may be performed outside of the detour time, for example, the shoulders may be closed as long as the traffic lane width is not affected.

This question is in regards to the note on sheey 4/15 DETOUR DURATION. In the answer, dated 7/22/2009, from a previous question about this note, the answer states, "All work to structure STA-62T-37.88 that would require a lane closure must be completed during the detour." All of the bid items for this bridge need a lane closure to perform the work. We would have to remove secondary members, heat straighten, jack and temporary support, remove main members, complete penetration weld along with radio graph test on the welds for the main member, install secondary x-braces, remove the temporary support, surface prep for painting, and apply all three coats of paint all in one weekend. There is no way to complete this amount of work in one weekend. We took this note to mean that the detour would be installed only when more than one lane was needed to complete the work. The only time we think this detour will be needed is when the temporary supports are installed. Please advise because there is no way to accomplish all of the required work in one weekend detour.

Please bid as shown. Work has been completed in this time frame for other projects.
