Please clarify a note on page 9/106, Item 614, PCMS, Class 1, APP. The note states that (6) signs are needed on site. Does this mean that 1 month paid will reimburse the contractor for having actually 6 PCMS on site? Or should the item have 36 months for the pay item instead of 6? Thank you.

Revised answer: The correct units for this pay item is 'sign-months'. The estimated quantity for this bid item is 6 sign-months. To the best of the Department's knowledge this is the correct estimated quantity.
