Sheet 7/68 says there must be one lane of traffic in each direction except for 60 consecutive calendar days when the road may be closed and detoured. Is the intent that the existing bridge including the deck and abutments down to the beam seats be demoed, the beams be jacked, piers and beam seats be extended vertically, bearings reworked, new abutments built and cured, new deck with parapet be built and cured, and the new approached built and cured in 60 days? Can this time limit be extended?

The intent is to perform the required work that can not be completed during the one lane restrictions set forth in the plan during the 60 day closure. The completion date will not be changed.

It appears there is a conflict between the noise restrictions and lane closure restrictions. On plan sheet 5 of 68, the note regarding construction noise restricts the use of power-operated construction devices between the hours of 7 P.M. to 6 A.M. On plan sheet 7 of 68, lane closures on I-75 are allowed between 8 P.M. to 6 A.M.
