Ref. Nos. 13 through 16 are related to the painting of existing Overhead Sign Supports. The quantity of each item is 18, however according to the table most structures are based on only a quantity of one per structure. Shouldn't the correct quantity be 28 based upon the 14 structures that appear to be getting painted. Please review and advise if we are looking at this correctly. Also please advise ODOT estimating that this project is specified as a SP-10 blast surface prep that requires removal of the existing galvanized coating and application of the organic zinc prime coat. This process is many times more expensive than the process that ODOT has historically used to paint existing sign structures and will therefore significantly increase the overall cost to perform this project.
