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Proceedings before Panel Members Robert
Taylor, Brad Jones, Richard Ortman, John Shanks,
and Amy Rosepiler, taken at the City of Columbus
Training Facility, 1881 East 25th Avenue,
Columbus, Ohio, on Friday, December 18, 2009, at
10:13 o'clock a.m.

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P R O C E E D I N G S
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MR. TAYLOR: Good morning, everyone.
This is the pre-bid meeting for the FRA-62D-1.21,
PID 17831, Construction Project 10-1001, otherwise
known as the Rich Street Bridge Project. My name
is Robert Taylor, District Bridge Engineer and
Project Manager for ODOT District 6.

Before we get started, I'd like to
mention a few things. Everything said in this
meeting is recorded by a court stenographer and
will be presented as a transcript. This
transcript will be included as an addendum to the
project prior to the bid opening. A copy of the
pre-bid meeting transcript will be available on
the ODOT Office of Contracts website in a couple
weeks.

I will give a brief overview of the
project, followed by a statement by Richard
Ortman, City of Columbus Project Manager. Then
statements will be issued about Environmental
Commitments. Finally, we will allow you to ask
your questions. When you have a question, please

1 clearly state your name and company name followed
2 by your question.

3 As I stated earlier, this is the pre-bid
4 meeting for the FRA-62D-1.21, PID 17831,
5 Construction Project 10-1001, otherwise known as
6 the Rich Street Bridge Project. This project has
7 a scheduled sale date of January 14, 2010. This
8 project will be constructed according to the 2008
9 ODOT Construction and Material Specifications
10 Book.

11 Part 1 of the project consists of the
12 replacement of the Town Street bridge on a new
13 alignment. The existing bridge was removed on a
14 previous project, ODOT Project No. 09-8000. The
15 new bridge will launch at the same location on the
16 west bank, but will connect to Rich Street on the
17 east side of the river.

18 The new structure will be a 5-span
19 precast and post-tensioned concrete rib arch on
20 reinforced concrete piers and abutments. Work will
21 also include the reconstruction of Washington
22 Boulevard from Rich Street to Town Street and will
23 also include some West Bank Park improvements.

24 Part 2 of the project consists of the

1 reconstruction 0.14 miles of Second Street,
2 including storm sewer, water, sanitary, lighting,
3 and signals. There is an interim completion date
4 on June 1, 2011 to have all work on Second Street
5 completed, including the intersection of Second
6 and Rich streets.

7 Please note this project had ARRA,
8 Federal Stimulus funding, which will require ARRA
9 reporting by the contractor, a review of change
10 orders by FHWA, and periodic project inspections
11 by FHWA.

12 There are a few items of note that will
13 be addressed in a future addendum:

14 4A note in the proposal is for a job in
15 Ashtabula. This will be corrected.

16 The 48 month duration for the field
17 office will be reduced.

18 General Note on 13/175 (part two), Bench
19 removed for storage needs location added.

20 Include a revised spec on how to move
21 the Chavous "The City" sculpture.

22 Add an alternate bid item to salvage the
23 limestone from the old Rich Street Abutment and
24 deliver to the FCEO.

1 Now, I will allow the City of Columbus
2 to make some comments regarding the project.

3 MR. ORTMAN: My name is Richard Ortman,
4 and I am the project manager for the City of
5 Columbus. The City of Columbus prepared the plans
6 for this project. The City of Columbus thanks
7 everyone for coming out today. This project is an
8 important project for the City of Columbus as the
9 City redevelops its Riversouth area of downtown.

10 I want to call to everyones attention
11 to the coordination of adjacent projects in this
12 area. Riversouth Phase 2 will be on Rich Street
13 from Second Street east, and on Main Street on
14 both sides of Second Street.

15 The Scioto Mile Phase 2 project will
16 redevelop Bicentennial Park and work along the
17 river from 70 feet north of the bridge project
18 limits to Broad Street. The Scioto Mile
19 contractor will need access to their project site
20 at the Second Street intersection and at the
21 Cherry/Second Street intersection.

22 The contractor will need to make sure
23 that coordination occurs between this project and
24 the surrounding projects.

1 MR. TAYLOR: Thanks, Richard. Based on
2 the Categorical Exclusion Level 4 Re-evaluation,
3 there are a few environmental commitments I would
4 like to bring to your attention at this time.

5 1. The specifications for erosion and
6 sediment control in ODOTs Construction and
7 Materials Specifications 2008 will be adhered to
8 during the construction of the project.

9 2. Prior to any lane or intersection
10 closures, the contractor will notify in writing
11 the City of Columbus TTC Coordinator, the Paving
12 the Way Coordinator, and the ODOT project Engineer
13 on site.

14 The Paving the Way Coordinator will be
15 responsible for contacting emergency services,
16 school district transportation offices, and the
17 public bus system regarding the restrictions.
18 Access to businesses for vehicles and pedestrians
19 is to be maintained at all times. A notification
20 time table and specific contact information is
21 included in the plans.

22 3. The contractor will be prohibited
23 from staging, storing, and refueling equipment
24 within the know boundaries of Genoa Park, West

1 Bank Park, Bicentennial Park, and the Downtown
2 Riverfront Walkway.

3 4. The contractor will erect
4 construction fencing along Washington Boulevard
5 and Town Street to prevent access to West Bank
6 Park and along the north temporary right-of-way in
7 Genoa Park to prevent access by the general public
8 during construction activities. And that fencing
9 is in the plans, shown on the plans.

10 The utility and right-of-way
11 coordinators were unable to attend the meeting
12 today. If you have any questions specific to those
13 areas, please go ahead and ask them today, but we
14 would need to get a response and post the response
15 in the addendum.

16 As soon as the stenographer is set up,
17 we'll be ready to take some questions. Like I
18 said, please state your name, the company you're
19 with prior to asking your questions.

20 Up here at the table, we have Richard
21 Ortman, who's already been introduced; Brad Jones,
22 our district construction engineer; John Shanks
23 from Burgess & Niple; and Amy Rosepiler from
24 Burgess & Niple.

1 So we'll pause and let -- are you ready
2 to go?

3 So at this point, we can take any
4 questions you guys may have regarding the plans.
5 And like I said, please speak your name, the
6 company you're with, and the question.

7 (Pause in proceedings.)

8 MR. STEVENS: TJ Stevens with Great
9 Lakes Construction Company. When is the
10 completion date for the park work and the walkway?
11 Is that going to be ongoing throughout the
12 contract, the Rich Street bridge? I mean,
13 total --

14 MR. ORTMAN: Their completion date right
15 now is June of 2011, almost during the completion.

16 MR. STEVENS: 2011.

17 MR. TAYLOR: You're talking about the
18 adjacent project?

19 MR. STEVENS: The adjacent project. It
20 will run totally concurrent with --

21 MR. ORTMAN: Correct.

22 MR. TAYLOR: Up until approximately June
23 of '11, yes.

24 MR. ORTMAN: And they're already under

1 construction currently, rebuilding the park.

2 MR. TAYLOR: All right. If we don't
3 have any other questions, I guess we can conclude
4 the pre-bid meeting. I appreciate you guys' time
5 for coming out today. And like I mentioned, the
6 project is scheduled for a sale date of January
7 14, 2010.

8 Thank you.

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Thereupon, the proceedings were
12 concluded at 10:17 o'clock a.m.
