To Holders of the OTE Standard Construction Drawings (SCDs) and Plan Insert Sheets (PISs):

As of April 15, 2005, two OTE Standard Construction Drawings (SCDs) have been deleted and two new Traffic Plan Insert Sheets have been issued. The new PISs are temporarily replacing the SCDs that have been deleted. They are expected to be reissued as SCDs at a later time.

The drawings and the separate SCD revision package are available from the ODOT Design Reference Resource Center (<http://www.dot.state.oh.us/drrc/>), or from the Office of Traffic Engineering's Home Page (<http://www.dot.state.oh.us/traffic/>), using the Publications/Documents link.

Revision details:

The SCD Index has also been updated, and corrected. The entry for SCD HL-20.15 was deleted. This drawing was deleted in July 2004, but the reference to it had not been deleted from the index.

The following SCDs have been deleted:

MT-99.30, Transition Area Delineation for Lane Shifts > 4 FT. (1.2 M)

MT-99.31, Transition Area Delineation for Crossovers

And the information from these two SCDs has been updated, rearranged, and issued, as an interim measure, as the following Traffic PISs:

209930, Work Zone Delineation on Asphalt Surfaces –

RPMs are used instead of TRPMs, use of 873 Wet Reflective Tape has been eliminated, and delineation of the tangent section between the crossovers or shifts has also been addressed.

209931, Work Zone Delineation on Concrete Surfaces –

Use of TRPMs has been eliminated, and delineation of the tangent section between the crossovers or shifts has also been addressed. Adjustments to be made for Winter have been addressed.

Per ODOT policy, paper copies of the drawings are no longer distributed to all holders. Revisions will only be available via the web pages noted above, or as part of a new set of SCDs. The SCDs and PISs are scheduled to be available only on-line after July 1, 2005.
