Excavation Activity on Graber Mills, Inc., property, 802 Navarre Road SW

Excess excavated material from the Graber Mills, Inc., property, 802 Navarre Road SW, that cannot be reused on the project to be disposed by the contractor in a solid waste landfill according to a petroleum contaminated soils (PCS) plan note.

Anticipated USACE Waterway Permit Special Conditions

No in-water work, including excavation of the existing stream bed, placement of new temporary (i.e., creation of new and/or expansion of existing TAFs [Temporary Access Fills]) or permanent fill and/or dewatering, shall occur below the OHWM of the West Branch Nimishillen Creek between April 15 and June 30. The Contractor will be allowed to maintain existing temporary fills, continue ongoing dewatering and perform work within existing dewatered areas during the in-water restriction dates.

The USACE waterway permit determination will be made based on the TAF information provided in the construction plan. The Contractor shall submit TAF design and schedule information to and coordinate all TAF activities with the Engineer. Deviation from the TAF information presented in the plan may require USACE Waterway Permit Reauthorization requiring additional time for processing with the USACE. The contractor shall not coordinate TAF activities directly with the USACE. The contractor shall not utilize any unauthorized TAFs below OHWM until such activity is authorized by the USACE.

A two (2) year maximum duration has been established for each TAF for the duration of project construction. Accordingly, it may be necessary for individual TAFs to be removed during periods of inactivity to ensure the two (2) year maximum duration is not exceeded and any one location within the West Branch Nimishillen Creek.

Only clean, non erodible materials shall be used for TAFs. Any temporary fills below OHWM shall be removed following completion of the authorized activity and the area of stream where temporary fill was located shall be restored to its pre-construction condition. Reuse of materials excavated from below the OHWM of the West Branch Nimishillen Creek for TAF purposes is prohibited.

Materials excavated from below the OHWM of the West Branch Nimishillen Creek must be staged in an upland site and disposed of in such a manner that sediment and runoff to streams and other aquatic resources is controlled and minimized. The Contractor is prohibited from using materials excavated from the West Branch Nimishillen as TAF and/or for stream bed restoration. Material excavated from West Branch Nimishillen Creek may be wasted by the contractor in an upland area within the project limits as approved by the Engineer or disposed off site as approved by the Engineer.
