**Description** – In 2017, ODOT’s Division of Planning rolled out updates to the award winning Transportation Information Mapping System (TIMS) application including a new and improved Create a Map page and the addition of a Crash Analysis tool. The TIMS application provides transportation employees, transportation stakeholders, and the general public a central access point for viewing, distributing, and analyzing Ohio’s transportation data through web mapping tools. Easily accessible via desktop or mobile browsers, this application is an “outside the box” web mapping solution that includes such features as emailing, sharing and bookmarking, analysis tools, custom printing, and upload and download capabilities to name a few. This application allows the casual user who is not a GIS expert to produce high-quality maps quickly with access to numerous data sets.

This short training class will show attendees how to access the TIMS program, turn on various GIS layers, and render and communicate results/maps. Each session will be held in a computer training room to allow for hands-on use of the TIMS application.

**Who Should Attend?** – Local agency employees (county, city, village, township), MPO personnel, consultants, and FHWA and ODOT staff.

**Instructors** – Each class will typically be taught by one or more of the following ODOT employees (depending on the class date and location): Ian Kidner, Stephen Hale.



**Registration Information** – Registrations are processed in the order they are submitted online, while seats are still available. There is no fee to attend; however, participants must pre-register. Any registrant requiring a reasonable accommodation during training (i.e., mobility or access) should contact Ohio LTAP prior to the course date so the appropriate arrangements can be made. *Note: this abbreviated training class does not qualify as an elective or other course credit under the LTAP Roads Scholar training recognition program (however, Roads Scholar participants are still welcome to attend).*
