

Title 23 Highways, Chapter 1, Part 450, Subpart B, Section 450.214 of the Federal Code explains the *State's obligations in regards to a statewide transportation plan*. The plan must encompass several features: cover all areas of the state, be intermodal, cover a period of at least 20 years, include consideration of bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure, demonstrate consistency with plans from metropolitan planning organizations, reference all plans that were included in the development of the statewide transportation plan, and include considerations of resources available to execute the plan including financial resources.

The most recent long-range planning resulted in ACCESS OHIO 2004-2030. Work on this document began in 2002 and concluded two years later. The Statewide Planning Section is in the initial phases of updating ACCESS OHIO with 2040 as the probable horizon year.
