

Specialized Transportation CY 2019 Letter of Intent

The Ohio Department of Transportation Office of Transit is pleased to announce that the 2019 Specialized Transportation (5310) application will be open January 1, 2018. In order to apply for 5310 funding, potential and existing sub-recipients are required to submit a letter of intent. The letter of intent should include the identification of projects desired. Also, the letter of intent will ask for the updated coordinated plan. The projects that your agency desire must be listed in an accompanied updated coordinated plan.

The Letter of Intent is due October 1, 2017. If your agency is eligible for funding, you will receive an email about the mandatory application workshop. To receive access to the grant application, applicants will have had to submitted a Letter of Intent and attend the workshop.
