

Q & A – 2015 Ohio JARC, Ohio New Freedom and Ohio Coordination Program Applications

Q: Where is the application for Specialized Transportation Program (5310) vehicles?

A: This application process is not for 5310 funds for vehicles. (Specialized Transportation Program proposals were due on March 21.) With the current proposal, however, you may request one or more vehicles but only if you currently have a JARC or New Freedom operating project and are requesting operating funding for 2015.

Q: Where are the budget workbook's tabs?

A: At the bottom of the workbook's window. You may need to maximize the workbook's window to see them.

Q: Can one applicant propose both a mobility management and an operating project?

A: Yes.

Q: Weren't JARC and New Freedom repealed by the new surface transportation program funding and authorization bill, MAP-21?

A: Yes, but the repeal has no impact on funds that have already been apportioned. Ohio still has JARC and New Freedom funding to allocate to future projects. Ohio also has leftover Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities (5310) funding.

Q: How do I answer a particular question on a form?
