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## Highway Construction Week of Aug. 6, 2018

The following is work scheduled to occur on state highways within the Ohio Department of Transportation District 1, which includes the counties of Allen, Defiance, Hancock, Hardin, Paulding, Putnam, Van Wert and Wyandot. The schedule of work is dependent upon weather conditions, and unless otherwise noted, work will take place during daytime hours.

### ALLEN COUNTY

**Interstate 75** between Bentley Road and state Route 103 will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project. Work will occur on I-75 over Riley Creek in Allen County and on the **county Road 15 bridge over Interstate 75** in Hancock County. The project is expected to be completed in late September. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

The project will have the following anticipated impacts to traffic:

- **Interstate 75 in both directions** is restricted to one lane in each direction through the work zone through noon on Friday, Aug. 3. Additional lane restrictions are possible at times throughout the duration of the project. A maximum width restriction of 13 feet is in place during the lane restriction.
- **County Road 15 (County Line Road)** over Interstate 75 will close Aug. 13 for approximately 30 days for bridge repairs.
- Variable speed limits are in place through the work zone. Electronic messages boards display the posted, legal speed limit, which will be reduced during construction operations and presence of workers in the area. The posted speed limit on the electronic boards is enforceable by law.

**Interstate 75** over Little Riley Creek, just north of Beaverdam, will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project. Shoulder restrictions are also possible during the project. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet is in place during the lane restrictions. Work will last through mid-August. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

**Interstate 75** under Swaney Road, just north of Beaverdam, will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project that will begin Aug. 6. Shoulder restrictions are also possible during the

project. **Swaney Road** over Interstate 75 will close Aug. 6 for approximately three weeks during the project. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

**Interstate 75 northbound exit ramp to Bentley Road**, Bluffton, is now open following a pavement repair project.

**Interstate 75** shoulders near the U.S. 30 overpass, just south of Beaverdam, are closed in both directions during a culvert replacement project beneath the interstate. Little impact to traffic is expected. Work is expected to continue through August. Work is being performed by Beaverdam Contracting, Bluffton.

The following **U.S. 30 ramps** in Allen County will be affected by a concrete pavement and ramp repair project. Work is being performed by Shelly and Sands, Zanesville.

- **U.S. 30 eastbound entrance ramp from state Route 696**, Beaverdam, will close at 9 p.m. Thursday, Aug. 2, until noon on Saturday, Aug. 4. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound and state Route 65 back to U.S. 30 eastbound. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 30 westbound exit ramp to State Route 696**, Beaverdam, will close 9 p.m. Friday, Aug. 3, until 6:00 p.m. Sunday, Aug. 5. During the closure, traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound, state Route 65 and U.S. 30 eastbound back to state Route 696.

**State Route 65** between Grand Avenue and state Route 115, Lima, is reduced to one lane through the work zone at various locations for work related to a roadway rehabilitation project that will last through the summer. Work is being performed by the Shelly Company, Findlay.

The following impacts to traffic are occurring:

- Traffic on **state Route 65** between Northern Avenue and Jacobs Avenue, just north of Casa Lu Al Restaurant, has been switched onto the northbound side of the roadway while widening work takes place on the southbound side.
  - One lane of traffic is maintained in both directions. The turn lane is not available.
  - Traffic delays can be expected during the project.

**State Route 81** from Wapak Road to Eastown Road, Lima, is no longer restricted as curb ramp work is mostly complete. Resurfacing of the route will occur in the coming weeks. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 117/state Route 309 (Bellefontaine Avenue)** between Shawnee Street and Elm Street, within the city of Lima, is now open following work related to a railroad grade separation project under the Indiana & Ohio Railroad, and roundabout construction at the intersection of Elm Street and Bellefontaine Avenue.

**State Route 117** between Bowman Road and the Auglaize County line will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

**State Route 696** between U.S. 30 and the village of Beaverdam will be restricted to one lane through the work zone during pavement resurfacing. Work is being performed by Shelly and Sands, Zanesville.

## DEFIANCE COUNTY

**State Route 15** (Clinton Street) over the Maumee River in the city of Defiance will have temporary, short-term traffic stops on Sunday, Aug. 19 during survey work on the bridge. Traffic stops will occur generally from 7 a.m. to noon and each occurrence will last up to 10 minutes. Traffic control will be provided by local law enforcement and the ODOT Defiance County maintenance garage. Work is being performed by the ODOT District 1 survey department.

**State Route 66** at Palmer Drive, within the city of Defiance, closed July 23 for approximately 30 days for the construction of a roundabout. Traffic is detoured onto state Route 637, state Route 111, Dietrick Street and Holgate Avenue back to state Route 66. Work is being performed by the city of Defiance. ([see map](#))

**Interstate 75** between Bentley Road and state Route 103 will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project. Work will occur on I-75 over Riley Creek in Allen County and on the **county Road 15 bridge over Interstate 75** in Hancock County. The project is expected to be completed in late September. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

The project will have the following anticipated impacts to traffic:

- **Interstate 75 in both directions** is restricted to one lane in each direction through the work zone through noon on Friday, Aug. 3. Additional lane restrictions are possible at times throughout the duration of the project. A maximum width restriction of 13 feet is in place during the lane restriction.
- **County Road 15** (County Line Road) over Interstate 75 will close Aug. 13 for approximately 30 days for bridge repairs.
- Variable speed limits are in place through the work zone. Electronic messages boards display the posted, legal speed limit, which will be reduced during construction operations and presence of workers in the area. The posted speed limit on the electronic boards is enforceable by law.

**State Route 12** between Findlay and Fostoria closed during the week of July 30 in the following locations for the replacement of two culverts. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 224 and U.S. 23 back onto state Route 12. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hancock County maintenance garage. ([see map](#))

- **State Route 12** between township Road 238 and township Road 215, between Arcadia and Findlay, is now open following the replacement of a culvert.
- **State Route 12** between county Road 330 and township Road 261, between Arcadia and Fostoria, closed Wednesday, Aug. 1, for approximately two days.

**U.S. 68** between Liberty Street and the bridge over Buck Run, within the village of Arlington, closed July 9 for approximately four months for a reconstruction project. Local access will be maintained throughout the project. Work is being performed by Miller Contracting Group, Ottoville.

The following detours will be in place through the duration of the project.

- **U.S. 68 northbound** traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30, state Route 235 and Interstate 75 back onto U.S. 68. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 68 southbound** traffic is detoured onto state Route 15, U.S. 23 and U.S. 30 back onto U.S. 68. ([see map](#))

**State Route 103** between the village of Bluffton and state Route 698 will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for a chip seal project. Work is expected to begin Monday, Aug. 6, and last for approximately two days. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hancock County maintenance garage.

**State Route 330** between North Street and state Route 568, north of Vanlue, will be restricted to one lane for a resurfacing project beginning Aug. 13. Work is being performed by M&B Asphalt, Tiffin.

**State Route 330** over state Route 15, Vanlue, closed May 29 for approximately four months for a bridge deck replacement. Lane restrictions on state Route 15 approaching the bridge are in place through the duration of the project. Work is being performed by E.S. Wagner, Oregon.

The following detours are in place through the duration of the project.

- **State Route 330 northbound** traffic is detoured onto state Route 15 eastbound, U.S. 23/state Route 103, and state Route 15 westbound back onto state Route 330. ([see map](#))
- **State Route 330 southbound** traffic is detoured onto state Route 15 westbound, state Route 37 and state Route 15 eastbound back to state Route 330. ([see map](#))

**State Route 568** between Bright Road and the Wyandot County line will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project beginning Aug. 13. Work is being performed by M&B Asphalt, Tiffin.

## **HARDIN COUNTY**

**State Route 67** between the city of Kenton and the Wyandot County line, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for finish work associated with a pavement repair and resurfacing project. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 67** between the Auglaize County line and state Route 117 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project beginning Aug. 13. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 81** between the village of Ada and the village of Patterson will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage.

**State Route 117** between state Route 67 and state Route 235 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project beginning Aug. 13. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 235** just north of state Route 67, north of Roundhead, closed July 31 for approximately four days for a culvert replacement. Traffic will be detoured onto state Route 67, U.S. 68 and state Route 67 back onto state Route 235. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage. ([see map](#))

**State Route 235** between the Logan County line and state Route 117 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 273** in the village of Mount Victory will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for finish work associated with a pavement repair and resurfacing project. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 309** between the Allen County line and the city of Kenton, including its overlap with state Route 235, will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for resurfacing. Work is being performed by Bluffton Paving, Bluffton.

**State Route 701** between state Route 309 and U.S. 68 will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage.

### **PAULDING COUNTY**

**State Route 111** between state Route 49 and state Route 500 is restricted to one lane through the work zone for resurfacing. The project is expected to be complete in early August. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 111** between state Route 49 and the Indiana state line will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a chip seal project. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

**State Route 49** between the village of Payne and the Defiance County line will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a chip seal project. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

**State Route 49** between Bailey Street and Houck Street, within the village of Payne, will close Aug. 6 for approximately five days for railroad crossing repair. Traffic will be detoured onto state Route 500 and state Route 111 back to state Route 49. Work is being performed by Safety Services Supply. ([see map](#))

**County Road 123**, approximately a half-mile south of state Route 114, closed June 18 through early September for a bridge replacement project over Hagerman Creek. The project is part of the Ohio Bridge Partnership Program, which is administered through the Ohio Department of Transportation. The program provides funding for the repair or replacement of municipal and county bridges. Work is being performed by Eagle Bridge Company, Sidney.

**State Route 500** between the Indiana state line and state Route 111 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for the removal of raised pavement markings. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

**State Route 500/state Route 613** overlap between township Road 47 and Riverview Drive, just east of the village of Payne, will close Aug. 20 for approximately five days for railroad crossing repair. The detours for each route are as follows. Work is being performed by Norfolk Southern Railroad, Norfolk, Virginia.

- **State Route 500** traffic will be detoured onto state Route 49 and state Route 111 back to state Route 500. ([see map](#))
- **State Route 613** traffic will be detoured onto state Route 49, state Route 111 and U.S. 127 back to state Route 613. ([see map](#))

## PUTNAM COUNTY

Bridge repair, pavement repair and resurfacing on the following routes within the Delphos and Ottoville area will have the following impacts to traffic. Work has been suspended for approximately one week. Work is being performed by Bluffton Paving, Bluffton.

- **State Route 66, state Route 190 and state Route 697** within the city of Delphos will be restricted to one lane at various locations for pavement repairs and resurfacing.
- **State Route 66 and state Route 189** within the village of Ottoville will be restricted to one lane at various locations for pavement repairs and resurfacing.
- **State Route 66, state Route 190 and state Route 697** within the city of Delphos will be restricted to one lane at various locations for pavement repairs.
- **State Route 66 and state Route 189** within the village of Ottoville will be restricted to one lane at various locations for pavement repairs.

**State Route 65** between the southern village limits of Leipsic and the Henry County line will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project. The project also includes curb ramp construction within the villages of Leipsic and Belmore. Work is being performed by Gerken Paving, Inc., Napoleon.

**State Route 109** between state Route 613 and the Henry County line, west of Leipsic, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project. Work is being performed by Gerken Paving, Inc., Napoleon.

**State Route 189** between township Road 16-S and state Route 115, west of Columbus Grove, closed July 30 for approximately five days for the replacement of two culverts. Traffic is detoured onto state Route 115, U.S. 224 and state Route 634 back to state Route 189. Work is being performed by the ODOT Putnam County maintenance garage. ([see map](#))

**State Route 189** between Ottoville and Fort Jennings will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for work being done in preparation for a chip seal project. Work is being performed by the ODOT Putnam County maintenance garage.

**State Route 190** between Delphos and Fort Jennings will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for work being done in preparation for a chip seal project. Work is being performed by the ODOT Putnam County maintenance garage.

**State Route 190** at township Road Q, north of Fort Jennings, will close Aug. 13 for approximately four months for the installation of a retaining wall along the Auglaize River. Traffic will be detoured onto state Route 634 and U.S. 224 back to state Route 190. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus. ([see map](#))



**State Route 634** within the village of Continental will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for the installation of curb ramps and sidewalks beginning the week of Aug. 6. Work is being performed by Gerken Paving, Napoleon.

## VAN WERT COUNTY

**State Route 637** between Feasby Wisener Road and Harvey Road, south of Grover Hill, will close Aug. 6 for approximately two days for a culvert replacement.
