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## Highway Construction Week of Nov. 19, 2018

The following is work scheduled to occur on state highways within the Ohio Department of Transportation District 1, which includes the counties of Allen, Defiance, Hancock, Hardin, Paulding, Putnam, Van Wert and Wyandot. The schedule of work is dependent upon weather conditions, and unless otherwise noted, work will take place during daytime hours.

**Note: No work will take place on the Thanksgiving holiday. This is the final weekly construction update from ODOT District 1 for the year. Updates on area projects will be provided as needed throughout the winter. Weekly communication will resume in April.**

### ALLEN COUNTY

**Interstate 75** under Swaney Road, just north of Beaverdam, will be restricted to one lane in both directions at times for bridge deck sealing on the Swaney Road overpass. Swaney Road over I-75 will be restricted to one lane. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

**Interstate 75** over Little Riley Creek, just north of Beaverdam, is restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project. Shoulder restrictions are also possible during the project. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet is in place during the lane restrictions. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

**Interstate 75** between state Route 81 and state Route 65, Lima, will be reduced to one lane in both directions at times for repair of pavement under warranty. Work will take place on the mainline lanes of I-75, as well as the exit and entrance ramps at state Route 81, state Route 309 and Fourth Street. Traffic will be maintained while work is completed on entrance and exit ramps. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus.

**Interstate 75** between state Route 81 and Napoleon Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction through the work zone for pavement repair. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

**U.S. 30** will be restricted to one lane at times in both directions at multiple locations in Allen and Van Wert counties for the sealing and patching of bridge decks. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet will be in place during lane restrictions. The affected locations are as follows. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- **U.S. 30** near State Route 115, west of the village of Cairo in Allen County
- **U.S. 30** between Leatherwood Road and Ridge Road, east of the city of Delphos in Allen County
- **U.S. 30** between Ringwald Road and Dog Creek Road, north of the village of Middle Point in Van Wert County
- **U.S. 30** over U.S. 127/U.S. 224, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County
- **U.S. 30** between John Brown Road and Dutch John Road, near the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County.

**U.S. 30 ramps** at the following locations in Allen and Van Wert counties will be affected by a bridge deck and pavement repair project. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- **State Route 115 to U.S. 30 eastbound entrance ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, closed Nov. 12 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound and the Fifth Street interchange back to U.S. 30 eastbound. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 30 westbound to state Route 115 exit ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, closed Nov. 12 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound, the Fifth Street interchange and U.S. 30 eastbound back to state Route 115. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 127 to U.S. 30 westbound entrance ramp**, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, will close Nov. 26 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound and the Lincoln Highway interchange back to U.S. 30 westbound.
- **U.S. 30 eastbound to U.S. 127 exit ramp**, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, will close Nov. 26 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound, the Lincoln Highway interchange and U.S. 30 westbound back to U.S. 127.

**State Route 65** between Grand Avenue and state Route 115, Lima, will be restricted to one lane at times through the work zone for placement of pavement markings. All other work on the roadway is complete. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 81** between Wapak Road and Eastown Road, Lima, will be restricted to one lane at times through the work zone for placement of pavement markings. All other work on the roadway is complete. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

**State Route 81** between Wapak Road and Conant Road, west of the city of Lima, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

**State Route 117** between Eastown Road and the village of Spencerville will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

**State Route 309** between Interstate 75 and the Allen County Fairgrounds, Lima, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for repairs of pavement under warranty. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus.

### DEFIANCE COUNTY

**U.S. 24** at Domersville Road (state Route 281) will be restricted through the work zone during installation of a new traffic signal. Work is being performed by Perram Electric, Wadsworth.

**State Route 613** between Railroad Street and township Road 218, within the village of Van Buren, closed Nov. 12 for approximately one week for railroad crossing repairs. Traffic is detoured onto state Route 18 and I-75 back to state Route 613. Work is being performed by Safety Services Supply. ([see map](#))

### HARDIN COUNTY

**State Route 37 (Martin Street)** between Smith Street and Lima Street, within the village of Forest, is now open following railroad crossing repairs.

The following routes will be restricted to one lane in various locations in Hardin County for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage.

- **State Route 53** between the city of Kenton and the village of Forest
- **U.S. 68** between the city of Kenton and the Hancock County line
- **State Route 81** between the Allen County line and the village of Patterson

### PAULDING COUNTY

**State Route 114** near Road 193, east of the Putnam County line, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a culvert replacement. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

**State Route 637** between the Van Wert County line and state Route 613 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

### PUTNAM COUNTY

**State Route 65** between township Road 8-H and township Road 7-D, between the villages of Ottawa and Leipsic, closed Nov. 15 for approximately one week for railroad crossing repairs. Traffic is detoured onto state Route 109 and state Route 613 back to state Route 65. Work is being performed by Safety Services Supply. ([see map](#))

**State Route 190** at township Road Q, north of Fort Jennings, closed Aug. 13 for approximately four months for the installation of a retaining wall along the Auglaize River. Traffic will be detoured onto state Route 634 and U.S. 224 back to state Route 190. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus. ([see map](#))

## VAN WERT COUNTY

**U.S. 30** near and under U.S. 224, west of the city of Van Wert, will be reduced to one lane in both directions through the work zone for repair of the U.S. 224 bridge. The shoulder on U.S. 224 over U.S. 30 is closed during repairs. The work zone and lane restrictions will be removed Wednesday, Nov. 21, for the Thanksgiving holiday. The work zone and lane restrictions will be put back in place Monday, Nov. 26, and work continues. Work is being performed by Evers Steel Construction, Cincinnati.

**U.S. 30** will be restricted to one lane at times in both directions at multiple locations in Allen and Van Wert counties for the sealing and patching of bridge decks. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet will be in place during lane restrictions. The affected locations are as follows. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- **U.S. 30** near State Route 115, west of the village of Cairo in Allen County
- **U.S. 30** between Leatherwood Road and Ridge Road, east of the city of Delphos in Allen County

**U.S. 30 ramps** at the following locations in Allen and Van Wert counties will be affected by a bridge deck and pavement repair project. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- **State Route 115 to U.S. 30 eastbound entrance ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, closed Nov. 12 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound and the Fifth Street interchange back to U.S. 30 eastbound. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 30 westbound to state Route 115 exit ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, closed Nov. 12 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound, the Fifth Street interchange and U.S. 30 eastbound back to state Route 115. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 127 to U.S. 30 westbound entrance ramp**, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, will close Nov. 26 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound and the Lincoln Highway interchange back to U.S. 30 westbound.
- **U.S. 30 eastbound to U.S. 127 exit ramp**, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, will close Nov. 26 for approximately 18 days for approach slab replacement. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound, the Lincoln Highway interchange and U.S. 30 westbound back to U.S. 127.

## WYANDOT COUNTY

U.S. 23/U.S. 30 between state Route 53 and county Highway 330 east, Upper Sandusky, will be restricted to one lane in each direction during work to remove median crossovers at county Highway 50 and county Highway 121. The crossovers closed in late August in response to an ODOT safety study of the U.S. 23/state Route 15 corridor in Hancock and Wyandot counties. Work is being performed by the ODOT Wyandot County maintenance garage.

U.S. 23/U.S. 30 at county Highway 330 east, Upper Sandusky, may be restricted at times for work related to the installation of a traffic signal. Work is being performed by Perram Electric, Wadsworth.



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
