Highway Construction Week of Oct. 29, 2018

The following is work scheduled to occur on state highways within the Ohio Department of Transportation District 1, which includes the counties of Allen, Defiance, Hancock, Hardin, Paulding, Putnam, Van Wert and Wyandot. The schedule of work is dependent upon weather conditions, and unless otherwise noted, work will take place during daytime hours.

ALLEN COUNTY

Interstate 75 between Bentley Road and state Route 103, Bluffton, will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project on I-75 over Riley Creek and on the county Road 15 bridge over Interstate 75. A maximum width restriction of 13 feet is in place during lane restrictions. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

Interstate 75 over Little Riley Creek, just north of Beaverdam, is restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project. Shoulder restrictions are also possible during the project. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet is in place during the lane restrictions. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

Interstate 75 between state Route 81 and state Route 65, Lima, will be reduced to one lane in both directions at times for repair of pavement under warranty. Work will take place on the mainline lanes of I-75, as well as the exit and entrance ramps at state Route 81, state Route 309 and Fourth Street. Traffic will be maintained while work is completed on entrance and exit ramps. Work is expected to continue through late October. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus.

Interstate 75 between state Route 81 and Napoleon Road will be reduced to one lane in each direction through the work zone for pavement repair. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

U.S. 30 will be restricted to one lane at times in both directions at multiple locations in Allen and Van Wert counties for the sealing and patching of bridge decks. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet will be in place during lane restrictions. The affected locations are as follows. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- U.S. 30 near State Route 115, west of the village of Cairo in Allen County
- U.S. 30 between Leatherwood Road and Ridge Road, east of the city of Delphos in Allen County
- U.S. 30 between Ringwald Road and Dog Creek Road, north of the village of Middle Point in Van Wert County
- U.S. 30 over U.S. 127/U.S. 224, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County

U.S. 30 ramps at the following locations in Allen and Van Wert counties will be affected by a bridge deck and pavement repair project. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- **State Route 115 to U.S. 30 eastbound entrance ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, will close Oct. 24 for approximately three days for pavement repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound and the Fifth Street interchange back to U.S. 30 eastbound. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 30 westbound to state Route 115 exit ramp**, west of Cairo in Allen County, will close Oct. 24 for approximately three days for pavement repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound, the Fifth Street interchange and U.S. 30 eastbound back to state Route 115. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 30 eastbound to U.S. 127/U.S. 224 exit ramp**, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, closed Oct. 22 for approximately three days. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound, the Lincoln Highway interchange and U.S. 30 westbound back to U.S. 127/U.S. 224. ([see map](#))

State Route 65 between Grand Avenue and state Route 115, Lima, is reduced to one lane through the work zone at various locations for work related to a roadway rehabilitation project. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

The following associated impacts to traffic are expected.

- **State Route 65** between Grand Avenue and Northern Avenue will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for resurfacing and the reconstruction of concrete driveways and sidewalks. The turn lane is not available.
- **State Route 65** between Northern Avenue (near the Northland Plaza) and Kenmore Street (near Casa Lu Al Restaurant) is expected to experience significant traffic backups during the week of Oct. 22 due to milling and paving operations. Milling will begin Monday, Oct. 22, and continue for two days. Paving will begin Thursday, Oct. 25, and continue for five days. Asphalt cure times will delay access to business drives for at least 40 minutes during paving. Motorists are advised to avoid the area.

State Route 81 from Wapak Road to Eastown Road, Lima, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for work associated with pavement resurfacing in the coming weeks. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

State Route 81 between Wapak Road and Defiance Trail, west of Lima, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

State Route 81 between McClure Road and Fisher Road, west of Lafayette, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement resurfacing. Work is being performed by Bluffton Paving, Bluffton.

State Route 117 between Eastown Road and the village of Spencerville will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Allen County maintenance garage.

State Route 309 between Interstate 75 and the Allen County Fairgrounds, Lima, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for repairs of pavement under warranty. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus.

Elida Road from just south of Fifth Street (Lincoln Highway) in the city of Delphos to its intersection with state Route 309 closed Sept. 17 for approximately 45 days during a joint and pavement repair project. The project is expected to open by the end of Friday, Oct. 26. Traffic is detoured onto state Route 309, U.S. 30 and Fifth Street back to Elida Road. The project is being administered by the Ohio Department of Transportation for the Allen County Engineer's Office. Work is being performed by Shelly Company, Findlay.

DEFIANCE COUNTY

U.S. 24 at Domersville Road (state Route 281) will be restricted through the work zone during installation of a new traffic signal beginning in late October. Work will continue for three weeks once it begins. Work is being performed by Perram Electric, Wadsworth.

State Route 2 between state Route 249 and the village of Hicksville will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a soil boring operation. Work is being performed by ODOT Central Office.

State Route 18 between the villages of Hicksville and Sherwood will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Defiance County maintenance garage.

HANCOCK COUNTY

Interstate 75 between Bentley Road and state Route 103, Bluffton, will be restricted to one lane at times for a bridge repair project on I-75 over Riley Creek and on the county Road 15 bridge over Interstate 75. A maximum width restriction of 13 feet is in place during lane restrictions. Work is being performed by Miller Brothers Construction, Archbold.

State Route 12 (Main Cross Street) between Western Avenue and Liberty Street, within the city of Findlay, closed Oct. 22 for approximately five days for railroad crossing repairs. Traffic is detoured onto Western Avenue/Broad Avenue, Trenton Avenue and Main Street back to state Route 12 (Main Cross Street). Work is being performed by Safety Services Supply. ([see map](#))

U.S. 68 between Liberty Street and the bridge over Buck Run, within the village of Arlington, closed July 9 for approximately four months for pavement reconstruction. Local access will be maintained throughout the project. Work is being performed by Miller Contracting Group, Ottoville.

The following detours will be in place through the duration of the project.

- **U.S. 68 northbound** traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30, state Route 235 and Interstate 75 back onto U.S. 68. ([see map](#))
- **U.S. 68 southbound** traffic is detoured onto state Route 15, U.S. 23 and U.S. 30 back onto U.S. 68. ([see map](#))

State Route 235 between township Highway 36 and First Street, within the village of Mount Cory, closed Oct. 24 for approximately one week for railroad crossing repairs. Traffic is detoured onto I-75, state Route 696 and state Route 12 back to state Route 235. Work is being performed by Safety Services Supply. ([see map](#))

State Route 330 between North Street and state Route 568, north of Vanlue, will be restricted to one lane for a resurfacing project. Work is being performed by M&B Asphalt, Tiffin.

State Route 330 over state Route 15, Vanlue, is now open following a bridge deck replacement. Lane restrictions on state Route 330 and on state Route 15 under state Route 330 are possible as work continues. Work is being performed by E.S. Wagner, Oregon.

State Route 568 (Sandusky Street) between Grand Avenue and Blanchard Avenue, within the city of Findlay, is now open following railroad crossing repairs.

State Route 568 between Bright Road in Findlay and the village of Carey will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project. Work is being performed by M&B Asphalt, Tiffin.

State Route 613 over Interstate 75, just west of the village of Van Buren, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for pavement repairs. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hancock County maintenance garage.

HARDIN COUNTY

The following routes will be restricted to one lane in various locations throughout Hardin County for pavement crack sealing. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage.

- **U.S. 68** between Kenton and the Hancock County line
- **State Route 81** between the Allen County line and Patterson
- **State Route 235** between the Hancock County line and the Logan County line

State Route 235 and state Route 309 at their western intersection, just north of the village of Alger, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a catch basin replacement. Work is being performed by the ODOT Hardin County maintenance garage.

State Route 309 between the Allen County line and the city of Kenton, including its overlap with state Route 235, will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for resurfacing. Work is being performed by Bluffton Paving, Bluffton.

PAULDING COUNTY

U.S. 127 between the village of Paulding the Defiance County line will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for berm repair. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

State Route 637 between the Van Wert County line and state Route 613 will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for sealing of pavement cracks. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

State Route 637 between township Road 169 and state Route 66, south of the Defiance County line, will be restricted to one lane through the work zone for a catch basin replacement. Work is being performed by the ODOT Paulding County maintenance garage.

PUTNAM COUNTY

State Route 190 at township Road Q, north of Fort Jennings, closed Aug. 13 for approximately four months for the installation of a retaining wall along the Auglaize River. Traffic will be detoured onto state Route 634 and U.S. 224 back to state Route 190. Work is being performed by Kokosing Construction Company, Columbus. ([see map](#))

VAN WERT COUNTY

U.S. 30 near and under U.S. 224, west of the city of Van Wert, will be reduced to one lane in both directions through the work zone beginning Oct. 24 until late November for repair of the U.S. 224 bridge. The shoulder on U.S. 224 over U.S. 30 is closed during repairs. Work is being performed by Evers Steel Construction, Cincinnati.

U.S. 30 will be restricted to one lane at times in both directions at multiple locations in Allen and Van Wert counties for the sealing and patching of bridge decks. A maximum width restriction of 12 feet will be in place during lane restrictions. The affected locations are as follows. Work is being performed by Complete General Construction, Columbus.

- U.S. 30 near State Route 115, west of the village of Cairo in Allen County
- U.S. 30 between Leatherwood Road and Ridge Road, east of the city of Delphos in Allen County
- U.S. 30 between Ringwald Road and Dog Creek Road, north of the village of Middle Point in Van Wert County
- U.S. 30 over U.S. 127/U.S. 224, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County

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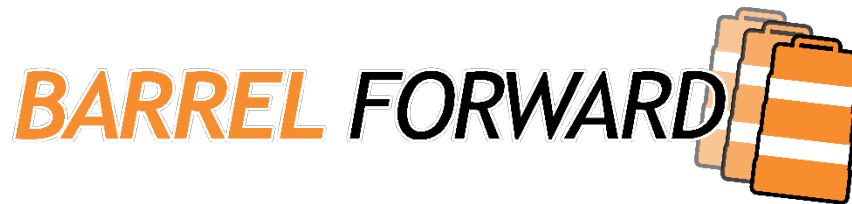
- State Route 115 to U.S. 30 eastbound entrance ramp, west of Cairo in Allen County, will close Oct. 24 for approximately three days for pavement repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound and the Fifth Street interchange back to U.S. 30 eastbound. ([see map](#))
- U.S. 30 westbound to state Route 115 exit ramp, west of Cairo in Allen County, will close Oct. 24 for approximately three days for pavement repairs. Traffic will be detoured onto U.S. 30 westbound, the Fifth Street interchange and U.S. 30 eastbound back to state Route 115. ([see map](#))

- U.S. 30 eastbound to U.S. 127/U.S. 224 exit ramp, within the city of Van Wert in Van Wert County, closed Oct. 22 for approximately three days. Traffic is detoured onto U.S. 30 eastbound, the Lincoln Highway interchange and U.S. 30 westbound back to U.S. 127/U.S. 224. ([see map](#))

WYANDOT COUNTY

U.S. 23/U.S. 30 between state Route 53 and county Highway 330 east, near the city of Upper Sandusky, will be restricted to one lane in each direction during work to remove median crossovers at county Highway 50 and county Highway 121. The crossovers closed in late August in response to an ODOT safety study of the U.S. 23/state Route 15 corridor in Hancock and Wyandot counties. Work is being performed by the ODOT Wyandot County maintenance garage.

State Route 568 between Bright Road in Findlay and the village of Carey will be reduced to one lane through the work zone for a resurfacing project. Work is being performed by M&B Asphalt, Tiffin.



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
