Description of Project:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing to replace the existing bridge structure carrying State Route 2 over Lost Creek at mile marker 9.01 in Defiance County with a new structure. Additionally, the guardrail and approach slabs will be replaced. Construction is anticipated to begin in summer of 2021.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The project consists of an existing stream crossing which is located within the floodplain. It would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work in the floodplain.
