

SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

Description of Project:

The City of Findlay, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Transportation, is proposing to construct multi-use paths to replace the existing sidewalks on Lincoln St. This will also involve updating curb ramps to ADA standards; as well as installing necessary signage and grading. The project will also include constructing shared lanes on the northbound and southbound curb lanes of Blanchard St. This will involve milling and paving the curb lanes of Blanchard St., adjusting catch basins, updated curb ramps to ADA standards, restriping Blanchard St. for shared lanes; as well as installing necessary signage and grading. Construction activities for this project will take place within the floodplain boundaries of Eagle Creek & the Blanchard River. Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2020.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The scope of this project centers around roadway segments that are located, in part, in the floodplains of Eagle Creek and the Blanchard River.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?

Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.

Were any mitigation measures utilized on this project? If so, please describe.

As per the Flood Development Permit for this project, there will be no net fill in the floodplains and the grade of the roadway and paths must match the existing conditions; therefore, no mitigation measures are needed.

To the best of my knowledge, this project has complied with all applicable Local, State, and Federal Floodplain protection standards.
