

SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

Description of Project:

The Ohio Department of Transportation is proposing to repair the shoulders on the west side of State Route 49 from the Van Wert county line to the Village of Payne. This repair will be done by reconstructing the edge of pavement in the southbound direction. Additionally, aggregate drains will be installed where practical (not in guardrail sections). Construction is anticipated to begin in the summer of 2021.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The existing roadway is located within the boundaries of the floodplain; as a result, it would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work in the floodplain.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?


Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.
