

SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

Floodplain Affected: Jennings Creek and Flat Fork Creek

Description of Project: The City of Delphos, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Transportation, is proposing to rehabilitate Lincoln Highway from Menke Street on the west side of Delphos in Van Wert County to Lehman Road on the east side of Delphos in Allen County. Rehabilitation will include replacing curbs and gutters, replacing catch basins and installing bicycle friendly grates, resurfacing the roadway, replacing curb ramps, filling in missing sidewalk sections along the roadway, and redesigning the current 4-lane roadway and turn it into 3-lane roadway with bicycle lanes. There will also be traffic signal and pedestrian facility upgrades and adjustments.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The existing roadway is located within the boundaries of the floodplains; as a result, it would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work within the floodplains.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?


Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.
