

SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

Floodplain Affected: Town Creek Floodplain

Description of Project: The City of Van Wert, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Transportation, is proposing to rehabilitate Grill Road, Kear Road, and Bonnewitz Ave in Van Wert County. Rehabilitation will include grinding and paving on the eastern roadway section, removing the outer 2' of pavement and reinstalling 3' of pavement on the western section; as well as installing under-drains, adding 4' shoulders, addressing drainage issues, and rebuilding existing driveways along the roadway. A portion of this work will take place within the boundaries of the Town Creek floodplain. Construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2022.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The existing roadway is located within the boundaries of the floodplain; as a result, it would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work in the floodplain.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?

Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.

Were any mitigation measures utilized on this project? If so, please describe.

Project activities will not change the alignment, grade, or hydraulic capacity of the floodplain; therefore, no mitigating measures are needed.
