

## SUMMARY OF FLOODPLAIN IMPACTS

**Floodplain Affected:** Auglaize River

**Description of Project:** The Ohio Department of Transportation, in partnership with the Village of Oakwood, is proposing a sidewalk project from on State Route 66 (First St) from North St to Celina St in the Village of Oakwood in Paulding County. Sidewalk work will include replacing the current walk with brick pavers. Additionally, inadequate street lighting will be replaced and street furniture (benches and trash receptacles) will be installed. Construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2022.

**Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?**

The existing roadway is located within the boundaries of the floodplain; as a result, it would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work in the floodplain.

**What alternative sites were considered, if any?**

Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.

**Were any mitigation measures utilized on this project? If so, please describe.**

Project activities will not change the alignment, grade, or hydraulic capacity of the floodplain; therefore, no mitigating measures are needed.
