Description of Project: The Allen County Engineer, in partnership with the Ohio Department of Transportation, is proposing a safety project that will install overhead signs, upgrade existing signs, and upgrade pavement markings at the Shawnee Road / Fort Amanda Road roundabout in Shawnee, OH located southwest of the City of Lima in Allen County. Construction is scheduled to begin in the summer of 2021.

Why must this project be located in the Floodplain?

The existing roadway is located within the boundaries of the floodplains; as a result, it would not be practical to reengineer the existing roadway to avoid work in the floodplains.

What alternative sites were considered, if any?

Based on the scope and purpose of this project, there are no possible alternative sites to consider.

Were any mitigation measures utilized on this project? If so, please describe.

Project activities will not change the alignment, grade, or hydraulic capacity of the floodplains; therefore, no mitigating measures are needed.
