ODOT District Two Ice and Snow Facts



Bowling Green, Ohio: ODOT District Two maintains state and federal routes in Lucas, Wood, Fulton, Ottawa, Henry, Seneca, Sandusky and Williams counties during ice and snow season. Below is information detailing ice and snow operations for the upcoming season including last winter's figures, helpful advice for preparing for and driving during the ice and snow season, and local garage information.

District Two Operations

Smart Salt Strategy: The name of the plan for ODOT crews to ensure safety, while being as efficient as possible.

Pre-Treating:

Brine: ODOT applies a saline solution (brine) to pavement immediately before the occurrence of a winter event. This helps to prevent the formation of frost, black ice, or a freeze bond of ice and snow to the surface.

Ice Bite (formerly known as Geomelt/Beet Juice): District Two will continue the use of Ice Bite, a pre-treating chemical derived from beets, on the metro Toledo interstate system and on various routes in Seneca and Sandusky counties. As an additive to rock salt and saline, this "beet juice" increases the effectiveness of salt and offers a good option for protecting environmentally-sensitive areas.

Pre-Wetting: Pre-wetting salt with the brine solution before roadway application also helps the rock salt to stick to the surface and jumpstart the melting process. In addition to pre-wetting salt with brine, ODOT also combines rock salt with liquid calcium chloride to better melt the ice in extreme cold temperatures.

Preparing for Ice and Snow Season

The public plays a key role during the ice and snow season. Below are some tips motorists can follow to have a safe and enjoyable winter.

Check and Replace or Repair before Bad Weather Hits:

- Windshield Wipers
- Defrost System
- Lights
- Battery
- Anti-freeze
- Exhaust
- Tires
- Brakes

Driving Tips during Ice and Snow Season:

- Give yourself extra time. Make sure to leave early and plan your route.
- Do everything more slowly. Accelerate, brake and steer more gently.
- Steer in the direction you want the front of your vehicle to go when you begin to skid. Brake gently or gently pump brakes if you do not have an anti-lock braking system.
