In accordance with section 5511.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director of Transportation will hold a public hearing at 7:00 P.M. EST, Tuesday, December 4, 2012 at the City of Fostoria Council Chambers, 213 S. Main Street, Fostoria, Ohio for the purpose of hearing statements on the proposed Abandonment of a portion of State Route 613 in the City of Fostoria, Seneca County, Ohio.

PROPOSED, THE ABANDONMENT OF EXISTING STATE ROUTE NO. 613 FROM NORTH COUNTYLINE STREET TO EAST CENTER STREET, SITUATED IN THE CITY OF FOSTORIA,

RIA, SENECA COUNTY, OHIO, SAME TO REVERT TO THE CITY OF FOSTORIA STREET SYSTEM EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY.

And, being more fully described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of North Countyline Street (United States Route 23 and State Route 199) with North Street (State Route 613); thence in a easterly direction along North Street to North Poplar Street; thence southerly along North Poplar Street to East Center Street (State Route 12) and there terminate. Said abandonment to include all those portions of the existing route not needed for any other State Highway.

Maps, drawings, environmental data, other pertinent information developed by the Transportation Department, and any written com-

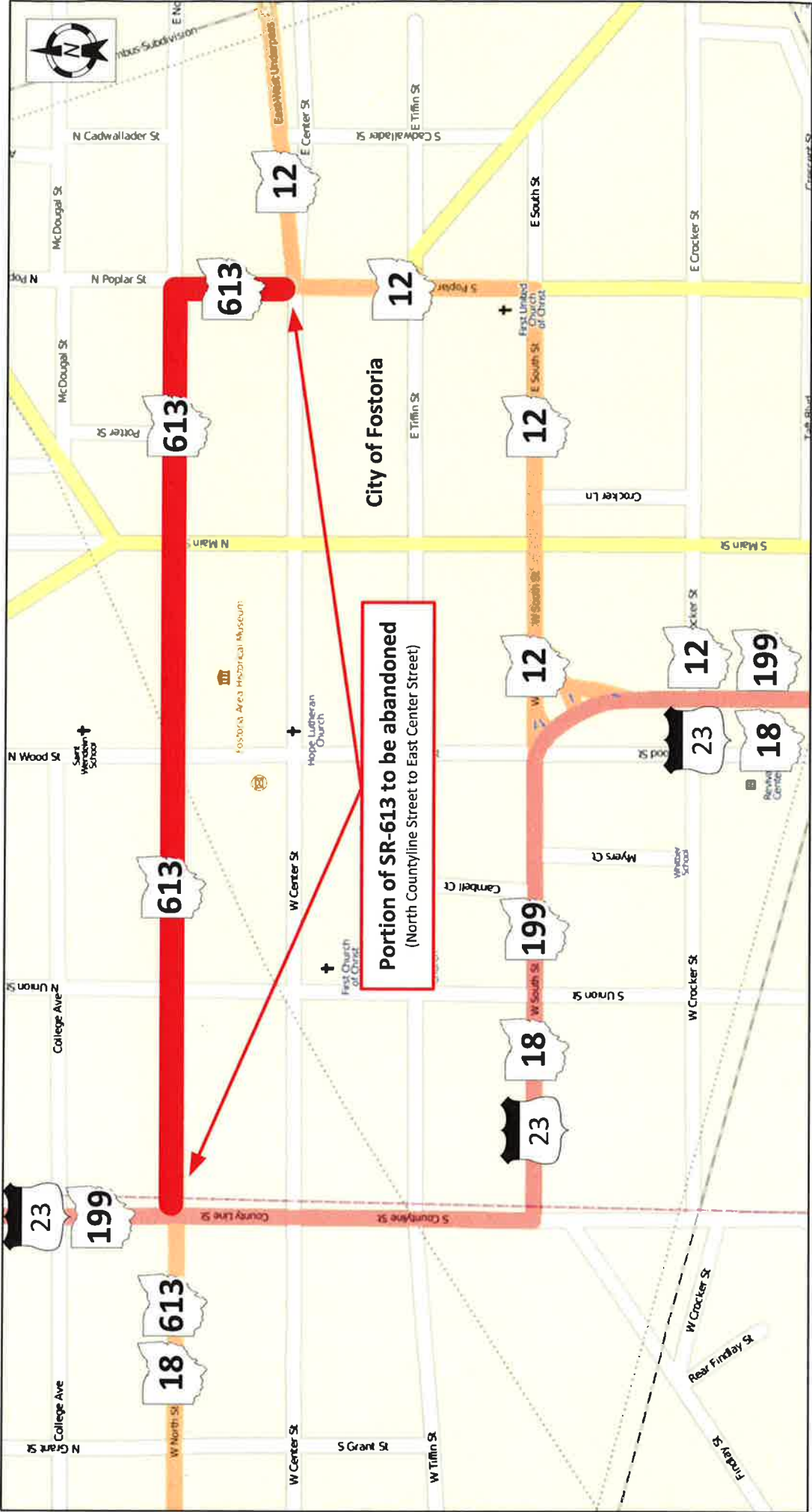

A RESOLUTION

Consenting to the abandonment of State Route 613 in Seneca County, City of Fostoria, Ohio.

WHEREAS, the City of Fostoria, Ohio desires to abandon State Route 613 in Seneca County, City of Fostoria, Ohio, from the intersection of the Hancock County and Seneca County line also known as County Line Street (US Route 23, State Route 199) to its termination point at the intersection of N. Poplar Street and East Center Street also known as State Route 12, and the total length of the abandonment being 0.57 miles; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Transportation, State of Ohio, in accordance with Section 5511.01 of the Ohio Revised Code, may, upon giving appropriate notice and offering the opportunity for public involvement and comment, abandon a highway on the state highway system or part of such a highway which the director determines is of minor importance or which traverses territory adequately served by another state highway, and the abandoned highway shall revert to a municipal street; a report covering that action shall be filed in the office of the director, and the director shall certify the action to the board of the county in which the highway or portion of the highway so abandoned is situated.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Fostoria, Seneca, Hancock, and Wood Counties, Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the Council of the City of Fostoria, Ohio consents to the abandonment of State Route 613, in Seneca County, City of Fostoria, Ohio, as aforementioned, and hereby authorizes the Mayor as the official representative of the City to send a formal letter to the Director of the Ohio Department of Transportation to request the same.

SECTION 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public, and in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.


THEREFORE, upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds (2/3) of all members elected to Council, this resolution shall go into effect at the earliest time permitted by law.
