

**Potholes** are a common nuisance, particularly during the winter season when the freeze/thaw cycle helps weaken the pavement. Roadways with a high volume of traffic are particularly prone to develop potholes.

**A motorist should ONLY report a pothole or damage from a pothole to the state if the pothole is on a state maintained roadway.** State maintained roads include all interstates and state and U.S. routes in unincorporated municipalities, such as villages or townships.
