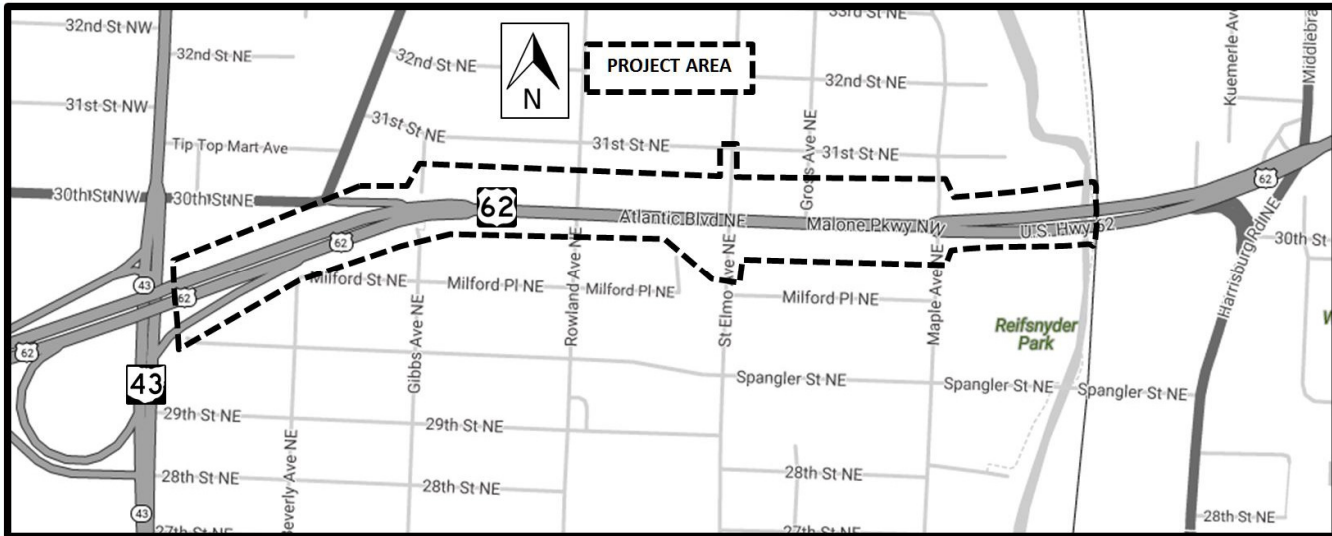

The public is invited to attend a public hearing concerning the proposed roadway improvements to the 0.95-mile section of US Route 62 (US 62) between State Route (SR) 43 (Market Avenue) and the east approach to the US 62 crossing over the Middle Branch of Nimishillen Creek in Plain Township, Stark County, Ohio. This is a formal public hearing to review and comment on the project's Environmental Assessment (EA). An EA document has been prepared for this project in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). This document outlines the social, economic and environmental impacts associated with this project and identifies the Preferred Alternative. The hearing will include a brief presentation at 5:30 p.m. The comment session by open microphone begins at 6:00 p.m. To comment at this hearing using the open microphone, you must register when you arrive at the sign-in table. **Written comments may be completed at the hearing or submitted before August 27, 2018.**
