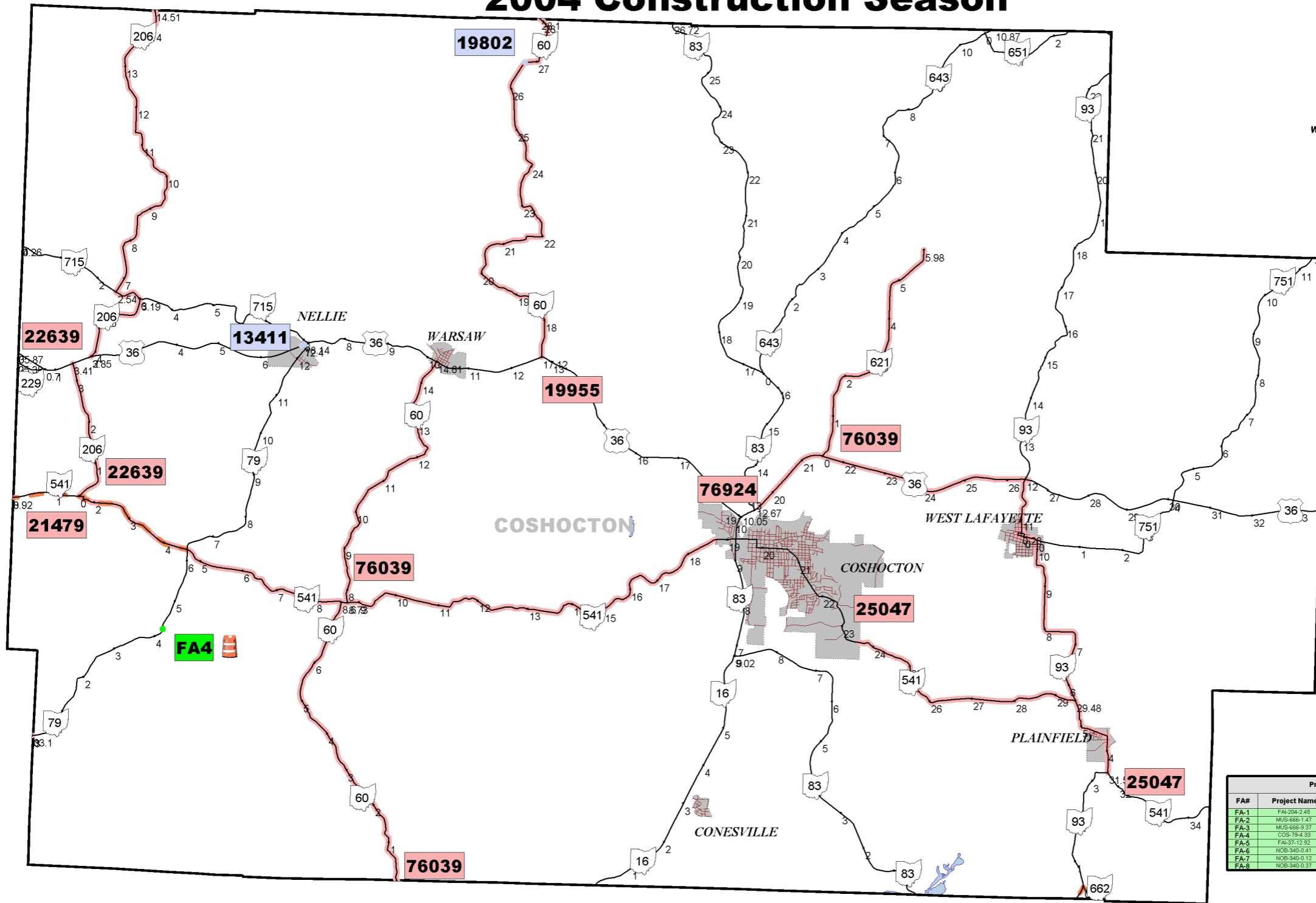


Coshocton County 2004 Construction Season
