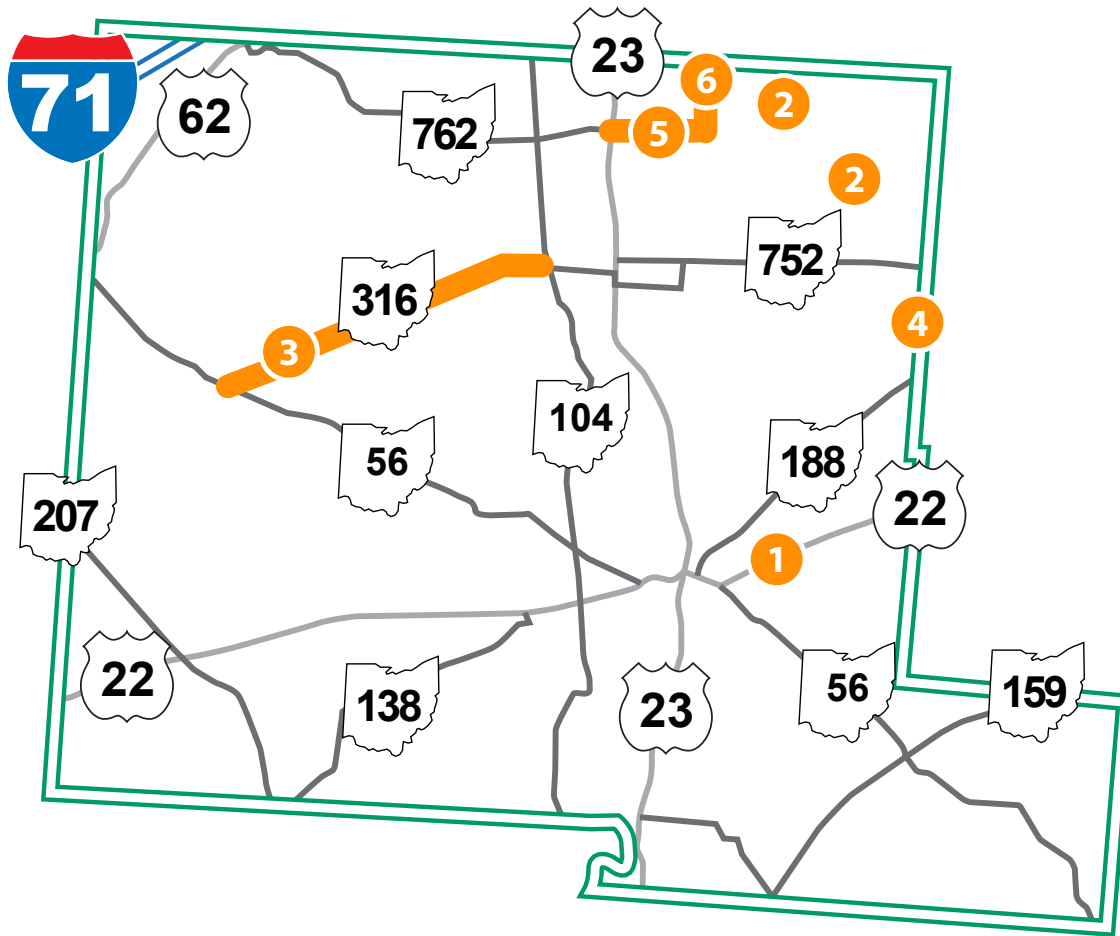


2014 PICKAWAY COUNTY PROJECTS



PICKAWAY COUNTY

1. Culvert Replacements

Start: May 2014

Complete: November 2014

Investment: \$1,330,000

Pickaway Co. - US 22 west of Bolender Pontious Rd. 30 day closure with incentive/disincentive.

2. Bridge Replacements

Replacement of Airbase Rd. (Township Road 95) bridge over

branch of Walnut Creek and Winchester Rd. (County Road 8)

bridge over branch of Walnut Creek as part of the Governor's Ohio Bridge Partnership Initiative.

Start: July 2014

Complete: October 2014

Investment: \$825,000

Traffic Impact: 90 day closures with detours.

3. State Route 316 Resurfacing

Resurface SR 316 from SR 56 to SR 104.

Start: May 2014

Complete: July 2014

Investment: \$1,391,905

Traffic Impact: Maintain one lane of two-way traffic.

4. State Route 674 Bridge Replacement

Replace bridge over Turkey Run, a mile and a half north of SR 188.

Start: April 2014

Complete: October 2014

Investment: \$1,097,742

Traffic Impact: Maintain one lane of two-way traffic with temporary signals. Short-duration closures to set beams.

5. Pickaway East-West Connector

Widen and relocate Duvall Rd. (TR 20) to three lanes, including a bridge over the railroad between US 23 and Ashville Pike.

Start: September 2012

Complete: October 2014

Investment: \$10,779,005

Traffic Impact: Maintain one lane only westbound with posted detour for eastbound traffic.

6. State Route 762 Reconstruction

Widen and construct roundabouts on Ashville Pike (CR 28) between Duvall Rd. and Rickenbacker Pkwy.

Start: August 2013

Complete: October 2014

Investment: \$6,541,131

Traffic Impact: Closure of Ashville Pike, Airbase Rd. and Duvall Rd. with detours.
