



I-270 Northwest Side Widening

Project Details

- Widens both directions of Interstate 270 from three to four lanes between Trabue Road and U.S. 33 on the Northwest Side of Franklin County
- Rehabilitates 10 bridges
- Upgrades all highway safety features including guardrail, cable rail, drainage, lighting and signing
- Constructs two noise walls
- The interstate will be widened within the existing median
- Traffic on this stretch of I-270 between Hilliard and Dublin is expected to increase by 30,000 vehicles a day in the next 20 years
- At least two lanes will be maintained during construction
- There will be coordination between this project and the I-270/US 33 interCHANGE project in Dublin, which will be complete this year
