



FULL CLOSURES: WHAT TO EXPECT

During the course of this construction project, several ramps are permitted to be closed so they can be rebuilt. Below is a list of those ramps, the closure duration and detour. The detour is the posted signed detour. You may know another route which you are welcome to use. The posted signed detour is for drivers who may not be familiar with the area.

At least one week prior notification will be provided before the ramp is closed. This includes portable message boards that you see along the road as well as email alerts from the Public Information Office.

There are two ways to get these alerts:
