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The update is a general guide to the construction operations on the I-70 lane addition in Clark County. Any time frames listed within are subject to change without notice due to changing weather or field conditions. This information will be updated monthly or as needed.

## January 2011

**Interstate 70** - The I-70 eastbound and westbound lane additions between SR 72 at the 54 mile marker and US 40 at the 62 mile marker are currently shut down for the winter. Prior to winter shutdown, an eastbound contraflow lane was built. The contraflow lane splits eastbound traffic into an express lane and an all exits lane with a grass median between them. Concrete barrier wall separates the westbound lanes and the eastbound contraflow lane. Two lanes remain in both directions. The eastbound contraflow lane does not give access to the SR 41 exit or the US 40 exit.

**Structures** - There is no structural work on project.

**Miscellaneous** – The contractor has a traffic crew available to check barrels, construction signs and patch potholes if required.
