

This publication is a general guide to the construction operations currently underway on the 70/75 interchange reconstruction project. Any timeframes listed within are subject to change without notice due to changing weather or field conditions. This newsletter will be updated monthly, or as needed.

## October 2009

**Interstate 70** – Traffic is in its final configuration.

**Interstate 75** – Two lanes of traffic are being maintained in the southbound direction and now three lanes are being maintained in the northbound direction from Little York Road to US 40. Crews are working on paving the outside lane and shoulder on the southbound side. The southbound side should open to three lanes of traffic the week of Sept. 28. **Please use caution and slow down through this area.**

**Ramp** – The ramp from I-70 eastbound to I-75 northbound is still closed and is expected to re-open the week of October 12, 2009. Crews are continuing to build the new ramp from I-70 eastbound to I-75 northbound. Trucks will be entering and leaving the highway from behind the barrels. **Please slow down and use caution through this area.**
