

The following final actions are recorded as permanent changes to the state highway system:

State Route 733

THE ADDITION OF STATE ROUTE 733, WHICH IS CURRENTLY IDENTIFIED AS CHESTER ROAD IN THE VILLAGE OF POMEROY AND COUNTY ROAD 7A IN SALISBURY AND SUTTON TOWNSHIPS, MEIGS COUNTY, OHIO.

Said addition shall begin at a point along S.R. 124 identified as Straight Line Mileage (SLM) point 22.19, said point being the intersection of S.R. 124, S.R. 833 and Chester Road, within the Village of Pomeroy; thence extend in a northeasterly direction along C.R. 7A (Chester Road) to the intersection with U.S. Route 33 Ramps A and D near Five Points; and there terminate.

The added route was previously abandoned following the completion of the U.S. Route 33 Ravenswood Connector, as journalized on April 6, 1998 in Entry # 10-MEG-1998-01.

The total length of S.R. 733 to be added shall be approximately 2.24 miles, as measured along the centerline of the roadway, and specifically identified by the above-referenced Straight Line Mileage points. 0.25 miles of the route lies within the Village of Pomeroy Corporation limits. The remaining 1.99 miles lies within Salisbury and Sutton Townships.

State Route 684

THE ABANDONMENT OF STATE ROUTE 684 IN SCIPPIO TOWNSHIP, MEIGS COUNTY.

Said abandonment of S.R. 684 shall begin at the junction with S.R. 143, being identified as SLM point 0.00; thence extend in a northerly direction along S.R. 684 to SLM point 2.97 at the junction with S.R 692; and there terminate.

The abandoned portion hereby reverts to the Meigs County Highway System upon this authorization by the Director of Transportation.

The total length of S.R. 684 to be abandoned shall be approximately 2.97 miles within Meigs County, as measured along the centerline of the roadway, and specifically identified by the above-referenced Straight Line Mileage points.

State Route 692

THE ABANDONMENT OF STATE ROUTE 692 IN SCIPPIO TOWNSHIP, MEIGS COUNTY.

Said abandonment of S.R 692 shall begin at the junction with S.R. 143, being identified as SLM 0.00; thence extend in a northeasterly direction along S.R. 692, passing through the junction with S.R. 684 at SLM point 2.25, to SLM point 3.19, and there terminate.

The abandoned portion hereby reverts to the Meigs County Highway System upon this authorization by the Director of Transportation.

The total length of S.R. 692 to be abandoned shall be approximately 3.19 miles within Meigs County, as measured along the centerline of the roadway, and specifically identified by the above-referenced Straight Line Mileage points.

State Route 124

THE ELIMINATION OF AN UNJOURNALIZED, PROPOSED SEGMENT OF STATE ROUTE 124 IN SALISBURY TOWNSHIP AND THE VILLAGE OF MIDDLEPORT, MEIGS COUNTY.

Said elimination of S.R. 124 shall begin at the junction S.R. 7, being identified as SLM 16.67; thence extend in an easterly direction to the Ohio River bridge between Pomeroy, Ohio and Mason, West Virginia, and there terminate.

The unconstructed alignment shall be eliminated from the State Highway inventory and associated highway system maps upon this authorization by the Director of Transportation.
