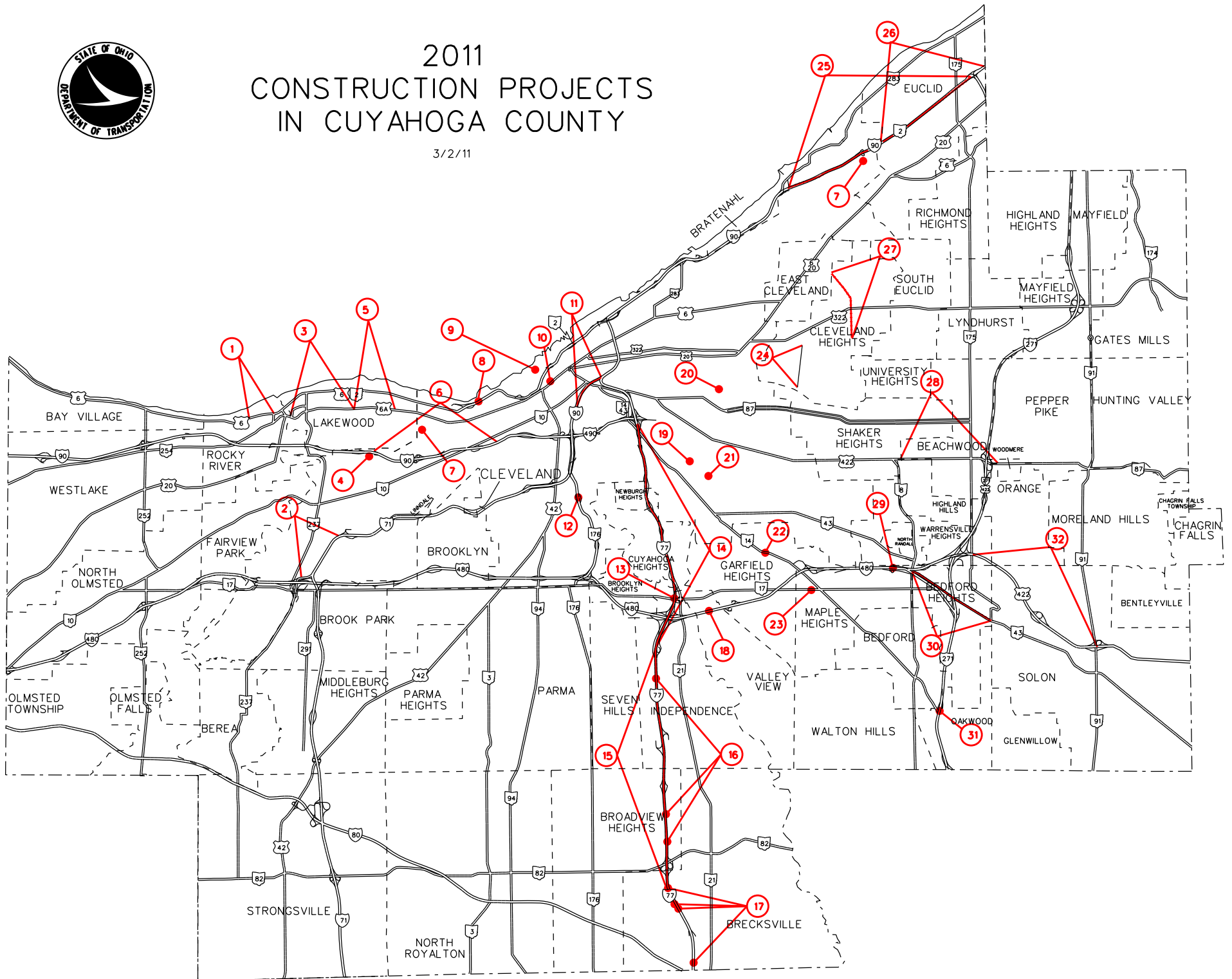

Map #: 2

Interstate 71, Cuyahoga County†

Replace noise walls along I-71 between I-480 and Puritas Road in the city of Cleveland. Includes replacing walls on the bridges over Holland Road and Sylvia Road south of I-480. Traffic will be maintained. Lane closures are expected during off-peak hours. Begin: April 2011/Complete: October 2011

Interstate 77, Cuyahoga County†*

All lanes along I-77, including the newly added lane, are now open. During the 2011 construction season, crews will complete the final surface course on I-77 north and southbound between Pleasant Valley and Oakes Roads including 12 entrance and exit ramps, painting and sealing of four bridges, noise wall installation, final grading and seeding work, guardrail work, pavement markings and highway sign and lighting. Daily and nightly lane closures are expected. The entire project adds a lane on I-77 between Oakes Road and Rockside Road. Begin: April 2008/Complete: October 2011

Interstate 77, Cuyahoga County

Resurface I-77 between Rockside Road and I-490 in the cities of Independence and Cleveland and the villages of Cuyahoga Heights and Newburgh Heights. Includes partial paving of I-490 ramps and median barrier replacement between Rockside and I-480. Two lanes in each direction will be maintained during peak travel times. One lane in each direction will be maintained during off-peak travel times. Multiple lane closures are expected on weekends. Overnight closures of each ramp are expected. Motorists will be detoured via adjacent ramps. Begin: April 2011/Complete: October 2011

Interstate 77, Cuyahoga County

Replace the bridge decks over I-77 at Snowville Road, Highland Drive, Valley Parkway, and Oakes Road in the city of Brecksville. Lane closures on I-77 are expected during off-peak hours. Overhead structures will be maintained at half-width. Begin: April 2011/Complete: September 2011

Interstate 77, Cuyahoga County

Replace the bridge decks over I-77 at Harris Road, Lacey Lane and Chestnut Road in the cities of Independence and Broadview Heights. Lane closures on I-77 are expected during off-peak hours. Overhead structures will be maintained at half-width. Begin: April 2011/Complete: September 2011

Interstate 77, Cuyahoga County

Bridge maintenance on the I-77 bridge over SR 17 (Granger Road) in the city of Independence. Traffic will be maintained. Lane closures are expected during off-peak hours. Begin: April 2011/Complete: September 2011

Interstate 90 Innerbelt Bridge, Cuyahoga County*†

On I-90, heavy truck traffic is no longer restricted, however it is suggested that trucks in the eastbound direction remain detoured via I-490 eastbound and I-77 northbound in order to increase traffic flow efficiencies. Steel repairs continue. Begin: October 2008/Complete: May 2011

Interstate 90 Westbound Innerbelt Bridge, Cuyahoga County**

Crews work to construct a new Innerbelt Bridge – the first of two – which will eventually carry five lanes of westbound traffic. Multiple lane and ramp closures are expected. The existing I-90 bridge will remain open, however motorists are advised to *Opt for the Alternate* and use I-490 and I-77 to avoid the construction zone. Interstate 90 Noisewalls, Cuyahoga County†*

Noisewall replacement along I-90 between East 200th and East 260th Streets. Intermittent lane and shoulder closures are expected along I-90 and North Lakeland Blvd. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: July 2010/Complete: spring 2011

Interstate 90 Barrier Repair, Cuyahoga County†

Concrete median barrier replacement on I-90 between Joslyn Road and West 73rd Street in the city of Cleveland. Traffic will be maintained. Shoulder and lane closures are expected during off-peak hours. Begin: April 2011/Complete: June 2011

Interstate 90, Cuyahoga County†

Lighting revisions adjacent to the eastbound I-90 marginals near Alger Road, Warren Road and West 140th Street in the cities of Cleveland and Lakewood. Traffic will be maintained on I-90. Shoulder closures are expected. Traffic will be maintained on local roads utilizing flaggers. Begin: April 2011/Complete: June 2011

Interstate 90, Cuyahoga County

Resurfacing of I-90 between SR 283 and SR 2 in the cities of Cleveland and Euclid and the village of Bratenahl. Traffic will be maintained. Overnight lane closures are expected. Begin: June 2011/Complete: October 2011

Interstate 480, Cuyahoga County

Patch the parapets of the I-480 Valley View Bridges over the Cuyahoga River Valley in village of Valley View and city of Independence. Work will include new fence on the bridges. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: May 2011/Complete: October 2011

U.S. 6 (Lake Road) Resurfacing, Cuyahoga County*

Lake Road between Wagar Road and Linda Street will remain closed to eastbound traffic through the completion of the project. Eastbound motorists are detoured via Detroit Road. Truck traffic may utilize Linda Street to access the businesses on Lake Road while eastbound traffic is restricted. Local two-way traffic on Lake Road between Morewood Parkway and the parking lot entrance for Lake Road Market, Grady's and Danny Boy's Restaurant will be maintained until permanent paving begins in the spring of 2011. Westbound traffic is maintained. The closure is necessary as crews work to install a new sanitary sewer main and sanitary connections to businesses and residents. Work will also include a new storm sewer main with connections to businesses and residences, new catch basins and new water service for

properties on the north side of Lake Road. Work will take place four to five days a week Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Begin: August 2010/Complete: July 2011

U.S. Route 422, Cuyahoga County†

Install median barrier rail on U.S. 422 between SR 175 and SR 91 in the cities of Warrensville Heights and Solon and the village of Orange. Traffic will be maintained. Overnight lane closures are expected. Begin: June 2011/Complete: October 2011

State Route 14 (Broadway Ave), Cuyahoga County*

Bridge rehabilitation on State Route 14 (Broadway Avenue) over Norfolk Southern at Henry Street in the city of Garfield Heights. Traffic on the bridge will be maintained at half-width using a signalized closure, allowing traffic to use the existing bridge. Chaincraft Road traffic will be maintained with one lane of two-way operations with either flaggers or temporary signals. The gravel access road to the Garfield Reservation will be closed between Chaincraft Road and Mill Creek Lane. Begin: December 2010/Complete: August 2011

State Route 14 (Broadway Avenue), Cuyahoga County†

Replacement and upgrade of four traffic signals at the on-ramps and off-ramps at State Route 14 (Broadway Avenue) and Forbes Road with Oakleaf Road and Fair Oaks Road near the Interstate 271 and State Route 14 (Broadway Avenue)/Forbes Road interchange in village of Oakwood and the city of Bedford. Traffic will be maintained. Temporary lane closures or restrictions during off-peak times utilizing flaggers and/or short work zones. Begin: March 2011/Complete: June 2011

State Route 17 (Libby Road), Cuyahoga County*

Bridge deck replacement of the State Route 17 (Libby Road) bridge over the Norfolk Southern Railroad and the Wheeling and Lake Erie Railway in the city of Maple Heights. Traffic will be maintained at half-width using a signalized closure, allowing traffic to use the existing bridge. Begin: March 2010/Complete: October 2011

State Route 43 (Aurora Road), Cuyahoga County*

Crews have completed resurfacing on SR 43 west of Rockside Road. Crews work to complete resurfacing on SR 43 east of Rockside Road. Traffic will be maintained utilizing flaggers. The entire project resurfaces SR 43 between Northfield and Richmond Roads in the city of Bedford Heights. Begin: July 2010/Complete: June 2011

Aetna Road, Cuyahoga County#*

Reconstruct the Aetna Road bridge over the CSX railroad west of East 91st Street in the city of Cleveland. Aetna Road will be closed during construction between East 91st Street and East 82nd Street. Traffic will be detoured via East 93rd Street, Union Avenue, East 78th Street to Aetna Road. Begin: May 2010/Complete: June 2011

Bessemer Avenue, Cuyahoga County

Extend Bessemer Avenue from East 87th Street to Union Avenue in the city of Cleveland. Bessemer Avenue will be closed at East 88th Street. Motorists will be detoured via Union Avenue and East 79th Street. Local access will be maintained during construction. Begin: September 2011/Complete: November 2011

Map #: 10**Center Street, Cuyahoga County#***

Rehabilitation of the Center Street swing bridge over the Cuyahoga River in the city of Cleveland. The Center Street Bridge will be closed. Motorists will be detoured for the duration of the project. Motorists will be detoured via Washington Avenue, West 25th Street, Franklin Avenue and Columbus Road. Begin: July 2010/Complete: June 2011

Map #: 28**Chagrin Boulevard, Cuyahoga County†**

Traffic signal upgrade on Chagrin Boulevard between Belvoir Boulevard to Orange Place in the city of Beachwood, and the villages of Highland Hills, Orange and Woodmere. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: May 2011/Complete: November 2012

Map #: 24**Coventry Road, Cuyahoga County†**

Traffic signals upgrade on Coventry Road between North Park Blvd. and East Overlook Road in the city of Cleveland Heights. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: May 2011/Complete: November 2011

Map #: 12**Denison Avenue, Cuyahoga County**

Bridge deck replacement of the Denison Avenue bridge over SR 176 (the Jennings Freeway) in the city of Cleveland. Traffic will be maintained with one lane in each direction on Denison Avenue over SR 176 (the Jennings Freeway). Heavy truck traffic on Denison Avenue will not be permitted to make left turns to access SR 176 (the Jennings Freeway). Heavy truck traffic will be detoured via adjacent ramps. Begin: April 2011/Complete: November 2011

Map #: 20**East 93rd Street, Cuyahoga County**

Rehabilitation of the East 93rd Street bridge over the Norfolk Southern and GCRTA railroads in the city of Cleveland. East 93rd Street will be closed for the duration of the project. Motorists will be detoured via Woodland Avenue, East 89th Street and Quincy Avenue. Begin: April 2011/September 2012

Map #: 8**Lake Avenue and West 76th Street, Cuyahoga County†***

Rehabilitation of the pedestrian tunnels at Lake Avenue at the West Shoreway and at West 76th Street and the Norfolk Southern Railroad and the West Shoreway in the city of Cleveland. The W. 76th Street tunnel is *closed* for major renovation until mid-summer of 2011. Father Frascati Avenue and the northern end of West 76th Street around the tunnel are closed to vehicular traffic during construction. The Lake Avenue walkway connecting Edgewater State Park and Clifton Blvd./Cleveland Memorial Shoreway will remain closed through May 30, 2011. Pedestrian and bicycle access via the West 65th Street tunnel is maintained. Intermittent lane closures on the Cleveland Memorial Shoreway are expected, however impacts to traffic will be minimal. Begin: August 2010/Complete: September 2011

Map #: 5**Lakewood Signals, Cuyahoga County†**

City wide signal upgrade project (Phase 2) on U.S. 6A (Detroit Avenue) between Arthur and Cohasset Avenues in the city of Lakewood. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: July 2011/Complete: July 2012

Map #: 3**Lakewood Signals, Cuyahoga County†**

City wide signal upgrade project (Phase 3) on U.S. 6A (Detroit Avenue) between Cleveland Metropark Drive and Lakeland Avenue in the city of Lakewood. Also includes signals on West Clifton Boulevard at Sloane Avenue and Arlington Road. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: July 2011/Complete: July 2012

Madison Avenue and Nottingham Road, Cuyahoga County

Retaining wall repairs on Nottingham Road under the CSX Railroad and Madison Avenue under Norfolk Southern Railroad in the city of Cleveland. Nottingham Road will be maintained with one lane each direction during 2011. Madison Avenue will be closed during the construction season and will reopen during the winter months. Motorists will be detoured via West 117th Street and Berea Road during construction. Begin: May 2011/Complete: September 2012

Taylor Road, Cuyahoga County

Rehabilitation of Taylor Road between Euclid Heights Boulevard and Bayreuth Drive in the city of Cleveland Heights. Traffic will be maintained. Begin: July 2011/Complete: October 2012

Warrensville Center Road, Cuyahoga County

Replace the Warrensville Center Road bridge over I-480 on the city of Warrensville Heights. One lane in each direction on Warrensville Center Road will be maintained. Overnight lane closures are expected on I-480. The I-480 ramps are expected to close for seven days. Not more than one ramp will be closed at a time. Begin: July 2011/Complete: May 2013

Willow Avenue (River Road), Cuyahoga County#*

Rehabilitation of the Willow Avenue (River Road) lift bridge in the city of Cleveland Vehicle traffic is maintained with one lane of two-way operations utilizing temporary signals. A 21-day river closure will take place in early 2011 however impacts to Cuyahoga River traffic will be minimal. Begin: June 2010/Complete: April 2012
