

# **BENEFITS FOR BICYCLES, PEDESTRIANS AND TRANSIT**

## *I-70/71 Columbus Crossroads*

### **Project 2G**

**Starts 2017**

**Completion: Fall 2018**

- **Pedestrians:**
  - Brick crosswalks and sidewalk extensions will be installed at the Mound and 3rd, Fulton and 5<sup>th</sup>, and Fulton and Grant intersections to improve the visibility of crosswalks and shorten their length.
  - Replace brick crosswalks and sidewalks at the Mound and High Street intersection.
  - A new crosswalk will be installed cross the east leg of the Fulton and 4<sup>th</sup> intersection, with a sidewalk extension to minimize the crossing length.
  - Street trees will be planted along Mound Street between High and 4<sup>th</sup> and along Fulton Street from 4<sup>th</sup> to Grant.
  - New, 10-foot wide sidewalks will be built with the new Grant Avenue bridge, along with decorative bridge walls, post top lighting and fencing to enhance the pedestrian experience and improve safety.
  - While not an improvement, the pedestrian walkway over I-70 at 5<sup>th</sup> will be removed.
- **Bicycles:**
  - The Mound Street bike lane will be extended from 4<sup>th</sup> to High.
  - A new bike lane will be constructed along Fulton Street between 4<sup>th</sup> and Grant.
  - The width of the Grant Avenue bridge will accommodate future bike lanes planned by Columbus.
- **Transit:**
  - Concrete bus pads and conduits for future electric power will be installed for bus stops along Mound Street, between 4<sup>th</sup> and High.
  - Sidewalks and concrete bus pads will be constructed along the south side of Fulton to connect new bus stops to 4<sup>th</sup> or Grant.

### **Project 2E**

**Starts 2018**

**Completion Fall 2019**

- **Pedestrians:**
  - A brick crosswalk and sidewalk extension will be installed along the north leg of the intersection at Fulton and 4<sup>th</sup> Street.
  - New brick crosswalks and sidewalks, along with a new traffic signal, will be constructed at the Parsons –Mooberry intersection, improving pedestrian safety.
  - Street trees will be planted along Fulton Street, between 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> streets.
- **Bicycles:**
  - The Fulton Street bike lane will be extended from 4<sup>th</sup> to High

**Project 3B**  
**Starts 2019**  
**Completion Fall 2020**

- **Pedestrians:**
  - A new signal at Broad and Elijah Pierce will eliminate the free flow ramp to I-71 north.
  - Sidewalks will be extended from Long to Broad Streets along both new urban avenues – Lester Drive and Elijah Pierce Avenue.
  - Street trees will be planted between Long and Broad.
  - New, wider sidewalks, along with decorative bridge walls, fencing and planters will be constructed on the Broad Street Bridge.
- **Bicycle:**
  - Bike lanes along Lester and Elijah Pierce will be extended from Long Street to Broad Street.
  - The new Broad Street Bridge will have new bike lanes.

**Project 4R**  
**Starts 2020**  
**Completion Fall 2021**

- **Pedestrians:**
  - A new traffic signal at the Fulton and Front intersection will improve pedestrian safety by eliminating the free flow ramp at Front St. and adding curb bump outs along the east side of the intersection.
  - The new Front Street Bridge will include 10 foot wide sidewalks.
  - Street trees will be planted along Fulton Street, between Front and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- **Bicycle:**
  - The Fulton Street bike lane will be extended to Front.
- **Transit:**
  - This project allows Livingston and Front to become two way streets.

**Project 6R**  
**Starts 2021**  
**Completion Fall 2022**

- **Pedestrians:**
  - Brick crosswalks and sidewalks are proposed at the Mound Street intersections with Short, Civic Center and Second for improved crosswalk visibility.
  - Street trees will be planted along Mound Street, from Short to Front.
  - A new sidewalk will be constructed along Short Street from Mound to Liberty Place.
- **Bicycles:**
  - A sharrow will be marked along Mound Street from Second to Front.
  - A new shared use path will be constructed along Short Street from Mound to the existing path across from Liberty Place.
