Sub-Committee Objectives

1. To support the other sub-committees of the Opportunity Corridor Inclusion Advisory Committee in sourcing, developing, and engaging diverse contractors and laborers.

2. Neighborhood Development
3. Jobs and Training

2. To the extent possible, understand and maintain a pulse on the community, as it relates to the execution and achievement of diversity and inclusion goals.
3. To provide tactical and strategic advisory support to the responsible operating entities.
4. To provide sub-committee status reports/updates at the meetings of the Opportunity Corridor Inclusion Advisory Committee to include:
 - Goals
 - Progress
 - Challenges
 - Recommendations/Suggestions

Sub-Committee Meetings

1. Meet as a sub-committee at least once, prior to each Opportunity Corridor Inclusion Advisory Committee meeting. The sub-committee should engage with designated representative(s) of the responsible operating entity on an as-needed basis. Additionally, meet with the members of the other sub-committees to support their need for contractor's laborers.

Sub-Committee Members

1. Each sub-committee will have at least 5 members. This includes 2 co-chairs and 3 standing members. Ideally each member of the Opportunity Corridor Advisory Inclusion Committee will be on at least one sub-committee.
