Sub-Committee Objectives

1. To engage with the operating entities that are responsible for, building on and around the Opportunity Corridor, to assist them in achieving their diversity and inclusion objectives.

Sub-Committee Area	Responsible Operating Entity
1. Road Construction	ODOT
2. Neighborhood Development	Opportunity Corridor Partnership
3. Jobs and Training	Ohio Means Jobs

2. To the extent possible, understand and maintain a pulse on the community, as it relates to the execution and achievement of diversity and inclusion objectives.
3. To provide tactical and strategic advisory support to the responsible operating entities.
4. To provide sub-committee status reports/updates at the meetings of the Opportunity Corridor Inclusion Advisory Committee to include:
 - Goals
 - Progress
 - Challenges
 - Recommendations/Suggestions

Sub-Committee Meetings

1. Meet as a sub-committee at least once, prior to each Opportunity Corridor Inclusion Advisory Committee meeting. The sub-committee should engage with the designated representative(s) of the responsible operating entity on an as-needed basis.

Sub-Committee Members

1. Each sub-committee will have at least 5 members. This includes 2 co-chairs and 3 standing members. Ideally each member of the Opportunity Corridor Advisory Inclusion Committee will be on at least one sub-committee.
