Cleveland Innerbelt Plan to Hold Public Meetings

For Innerbelt, Quigley Road Connector

June 9, 2005, CLEVELAND, OHIO...The Ohio Department of Transportation District 12 will host two public meetings to present information about the status the Cleveland Innerbelt Plan and related projects.

- **Cleveland Innerbelt Plan Public Meeting**

ODOT is hosting this public meeting to review feasible alternatives being pursued as engineering studies move forward.

- **Quigley Road Connector Public Meeting**

June 16, 2005

5:30 – 8:30 p.m.

MetroHealth Medical Center, Scott Auditorium, 2500 MetroHealth Drive.

ODOT will present information related to the Quigley Road Connector, the first component of the Innerbelt Plan scheduled to be constructed.

At the Innerbelt Plan public meeting, ODOT will present the Feasible Alternatives. ODOT will take comments at the meeting and throughout the summer. In the fall of 2005, ODOT will present the Recommended Preferred Alternative and hopes to have a finalized Preferred Alternative approved by late 2006. Funding is committed for the reconstruction of the Cleveland Innerbelt and related projects starting in state fiscal year 2006.

At the Quigley Road Connector public meeting, ODOT will present the Preliminary Design for the construction of an extension of Quigley Road to Interstate 71 at West 14th Street. The Connector is the first component of the Innerbelt Plan scheduled to be constructed, as soon as 2006.

The Cleveland Urban Core Projects Advisory Committee will convene for their second committee meeting on June 14 at 9 a.m. at NOACA, 1299 Superior Ave.
