



Public Hearing Meeting Minutes for November 12, 2009

Director Molitoris noted that in December last year we ratified the new project selection criteria after much work in the field with partners like you and those advocating for transportation projects, and how transportation impacts the quality of life in Ohio. We are asking for new and important information and will continue to work with project sponsors to better understand these projects to ultimately help TRAC make better recommendations to the department on which projects to advance.


