



Public Hearing Meeting Minutes for November 5, 2009
Miami University, Community Room in Johnston Hall, Middletown, Ohio

Director Molitoris noted that in December last year we ratified the new project selection criteria after much work in the field with partners like you and those advocating for transportation projects, and how transportation impacts the quality of life in Ohio. 
