Requirements for inclusion on the Qualified Product List (QPL)

1. Submit to the Office of Materials Management the following information:

- a. Manufacturer's letter certifying the fibers supplied to the project will meet or exceed Departmental specifications
- b. Provide certified test data for the product
- c. Typical package markings that identifying manufacturer and brand name
- d. Agreement to immediately notify the Department on any changes in production, materials, dimensions, before shipment.
- e. Provide the Department a contact name, number, and e-mail address
- f. Supply both the finished product as well as a 10-foot sample
- g. Supply the Quality Control testing and frequency plan per SS-826
- h. Provide material certification that more than 55% of the material is of domestic origin. If it is not of domestic origin, please provide the location in which the material is manufactured for review as part of the IIJA/BABA requirements.

2. Acceptance by the Department

The Office of Materials Management will review a manufacturer's submittal for compliance with specification requirements.

Accepted products will be listed on the Department's qualified product list web page and will be loaded into the Department's construction database system for acceptance in the field through the QPL screen.

3. Field Documentation Requirements

Products on the QPL will be accepted if they can be identified by the field to a supplier/manufacturer listed on the Department's Qualified Products List.

Products should be labeled with brand name

4. Recertification Requirements

- a. Provide all re-certification documentation and samples as described in Section 1 by January 1st of each year.
- b. Failure to provide documentation by January 1st will results in removal from QPL until documentation is supplied.
