ODOT CMS 422.06 requires the removal of all existing pavement markings, except 740.02 (traffic paint), using abrasion method conforming to 614.11,G. What is the material of the existing pavement markings and will removal be required for this project? If marking removal is required on the interlayer chip seal, will ODOT accept grinding method for removal of markings?

Pavement marking inventory data shows traffic paint for the existing long-line pavement markings and polyester for other markings. Per CMS 614.11 G, grinding may be used if existing pavement marking removal is required since the chip seal interlayer will be covered by the asphalt concrete surface course prior to project completion.

Please confirm on pg 9/11 that the state wants to stop the rumble strips short of the pavement edge? On past jobs they have changed them to the edge of the pavement to allow for drainage. If so additional footage will be needed.

The rumble strips should stop short of the pavement edge as shown in the plan.
