Pg.44 - Bridge ATB-45-0845:

1.The detail shows the existing bridge with 3" of asphalt and Wearing Course Removed of 3" of Bit. Asphalt Concrete. The existing bridge is concrete.

Q: Should this item be item deleted?

2.The same bidge also has a quantity of 245 sy of Pavement Planing on Pg.42 in the Estimated Quantities.

Q:Is the intent to mill a butt joint on both sides the bridge? If so should the 448-II be deleted and the bridge not be paved with 448-I? Please clarify.

Pg.45 - Bridge ATB-45-1091:

1.The detail shows Wearing Course Removed on both Approach Slabs. Both Approach Slabs on this bridge are concrete.

Q: Should this item be changed if the concrete is to be milled or should it be deleted?

2.The Estimated Quantities on Pg. 45 for the same bridge shows 200 sy of Pavement Planing and on Pg.15 in the "Pavement Data" shows 338.4 sy of Wearing Course Removed in the same area.

Q:Could you please clarify?

On Pg. 5 - Item 448-I Pg64-22 Drives - it states that "Driveways shall be paved after completion of the surface course".

Ref. 48 448-I Drives covers the above item. The quantity is also covered under Ref. 46 446-I Surface course as stated in the general summary on Pg. 14.

Q: Since the plans state that the drives are to be paved after the surface course, shouldn't the 366 cy not be included in this item?
