Upon review of the ready mix concrete quotes there is a significant price difference between the various shades/colors for the concrete no-mow strip. Since we have no control over which color is chosen by the US Forest Service, unless directed otherwise, we will bid the cheapest option and expect reimbursement for any additional cost incurred if a more expensive option is selected.

The payment for the tensioned cable barrier (including the no-mow strip) covers the full price of all of the color options that the contractor presents to the US Forest Service as per the note on plan sheet 7. No price adjustments will be made after bids are accepted based on which option the US Forest Service selects from the options presented by the Contractor.
