Plan page 4 has an "As Per Plan" note for the decorative light pole stating that the aluminum pole and anchor bolts must be American made. The spec goes on name specific acceptable products. Holophane's model CHA16FSJ12P01ABGBK is listed as acceptable, however it is not an American made pole. Please clarify if that this Holophane model is acceptable although not American made.

The reference to American made shall only be required for the steel anchor bolts or any other steel or iron item, per CMS 106.09

The bid items and quantities provided do not reference any granular base material for the new sidewalk and the typical section does not show any granular base. Can bidders assume that the new walk is to be installed at the same elevation as the existing walk to be removed with no granular material required or should there be a bid item for either 304 or 411 for areas where the grade needs to be changed or adjusted? Is the existing walk on granular base and can we assume that whatever subgrade material the existing walk is on will serve as suitable subbase for the new walk at existing elevations?

Bid Item # 17 is for a SWPPP 1 LS but there is no corresponding Bid Item for Erosion Control measures (usually given as an allowance amount). Please clarify. Bid Item #33 is for Ground Rod 1 each. A quick review of the plans shows that 1 ground rod was included at the lighting control center but there are no ground rods shown at each light pole as is often the case. Please clarify that this quantity is correct.

An addendum is forthcoming to add this item of work to the project. The ground rod quantity is correct.
