The general note for this item states that all debris, material, vegetation, etc., is to be removed from within the linear grading limits. The area shown on the page 10 of the plans from SLM 3.6 to SLM 4.79 is quite wide. Could you please define the limits of the linear grading as a certain width from edge of paving? Would this area fall under item 209 Ditch Cleanout?

On the Shoulder Data sheets (10 and 11) it is called out in the columns labeled "Proposed Width" and the specific column is the "B" columns, both Left and Right. Dimension "B" is the width of the Item 209. Linear Grading.
