On page 5 of the plans, the Mow Strip note indicates that "the mow strip shall be integral to the socketed concrete foundation". We request a clarification to allow for the placement of sleeves in the concrete mow strip that the socketed concrete post foundations could be subsequently placed in.

Addendum 1 revised the Item Special - Mow Strip to allow the Concrete Foundation Socketed Line Posts to be poured separately from the mow strip.

**Question Number:** 3

Plan Sheet 4 Item Special-Misc.: Mow Striplf per the manufacturer's recommendation or if the manufacturer has no issue with constructing the concrete mow strip separate from the post foundation [not integral with], will this be permitted. Obviously the asphalt mow strip is not constructed integrally with the foundation. This will permit more accurate post/sleeve socket alignment.

Will we be able to drill through the concrete mow strip to pour and set foundations? Will lane closures be required when working adjacent to the travelled lane? (4' inside shoulder. The completion date does not seem reasonable to coordinate 85653' of mow strip and cable installation. Please review.

A1: The contractor can use whatever method he so chooses as long as the mow strip is not damaged during the drilling process or will become damaged in the future (i.e. no expansion joint between the mow strip and the concrete socketed line post).A2: Lane closures will not be required provided the contractor's equipment is not encroaching onto the travelled lane.A3: We will not change the completion date.

Addendum #1 is dated 5/24/10, but we just now happened to see it on your website. We still have not received an e-mail to notify us of this addeendum as has been common practice. This addendum has significantly increased the quantities and deleted cable rail in Clark County and added several runs in Miami County.
