By way of clarification regarding construction procedures for Ref. 0072 (Meter, Setting, Stop and Chamber), I discussed the requirements of moving the meters on this project from their existing location to the new location shown on the drawings with Lyle Bloom at the Clermont County Water & Sewer Dept. According to Mr. Bloom, they want to have a completely new service run from the main to the new meter setting location.

Of course, the current way the pay item is set up, it does not include payment for a new water service line.
