The general notes on page 120 of the plans state the waterline is to be constructed according to Clermont County Specifications. The watermain details on page 126 of the plans show bedding and backfill of the watermain as ODOT item 703.11 Type 1. Clermont county specifications 401.6 and 202.2 state ODOT 703.11 Type 2 should be used for bedding and backfill. Please clarify whether Type 1 or Type 2 backfill should be used for the bedding and backfill of the waterline.

The plan note on page 8A, in the middle column under "Work involving asbestos containing material", the first sentence states this project will require the demolition/renovation of several existing buildings. The proposal does not list any pay items for demolition of buildings. The plans do not indicate which buildings will be removed. Please clarify which buildings will require the asbestos inspection, and how the demolition of these buildings will be paid for.

Bid item #108 1" copper service branch proposal amount states 19 linear feet but the work summary on page 124 of 163 states that there is 29 linear feet. Please clarify

In reference to bid items 103-106. The proposal calls out for mechanical joints and fittings. Is it the intent of ODOT to make the contractor install mechanical joints or can push on joints with mechanical fittings be used? The proposal also calls for "cutting-in-sleeves" but the plans show tees and wyes. Which should we bid?
