On pages 32 and 33 of the plans it shows traffic drums to block off the turn lanes on US 22 to ramps W and Z. Is it the intent to use traffic drums or portable concrete barrier wall and impact attenuators in these areas based on the information in Addendum # 1 for this project?

**As per the note within Addendum #1 for Item 614 Maintaining Traffic Misc. : Expressway Closure - The note added Standard Construction Drawing MT-99.51 - which details the requirements for "Freeway/Expressway Closure using Temporary Concrete Median Barrier". Please refer to the actual standard construction drawing and it's requirements. The note also added Standard Construction drawing for MT-101.60 - which details the requirements of "Road Closure using Type III Barricades". Please refer to the standard construction drawing and it's requirements. Neither of the above standard construction drawings require the barrels (as noted in the question) to be revised to concrete barrier& impact attenuator for sheet 32& 33. Therefore barrels are to be used as the plan and addendum indicate for sheet 32 -**
