PG. 4 of the plans show 200 CY of 253 pavement repair. Can the Dept. breakdown the quantity by location so we can bid accordingly? Please respond by addendum since pre-bid questions are not considered part of the contract documents.

On plan sheet 5, maintenance of traffic note III-4, the note states that I-271 express lanes may all be closed according to Permitted Lane Closure Times. Plan sheet 6, Schedule of Through Lanes Maintained directs to the web site for the lane closure list. The web site states no two lane closures permitted. Does the plan note apply?

The note on plan sheet 5 gives the contractor the option of closing one lane of the express lanes "or close the entire express lanes within these same time limitations" which correspond to the one lane closure times permitted on the Permitted Lane Closure Times note.

Ref #11 EBS file & Plan page 7A show quantity as 400 CY. Plan page 3 has quantity as 400 SY being used for average 40 x 4 repairs on 271 express lanes. By using EBS & Page 7A = approximately 400 repairs Using plan page 3 = Approximately 23 repairs Which is correct?
